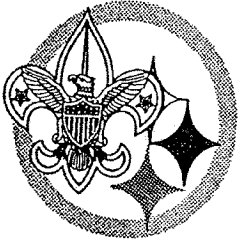

Dear Paul:

I well recall the correspondence and conversations we had about a year ago in regard to the above Scouter. I also, at that time, forwarded to you copies of the journal-entries of the County Court that confirmed his conviction on a morals charge.

I was not aware that Mr. Jordan's registration was approved on a two-year probationary basis. I thought that he had been removed from our registration, and, in fact, I secured from him his registration card. He should not, under any circumstances, be allowed to register in the Boy Scouts of America in light of his conviction, and since boys, fourteen and under, are the males with whom he gets involved.

In the event that he has not been removed from eligibility for registration in the Boy Scouts of America, please do so at once and if I need to send additional supporting material, I will be happy to do so.

In the above captioned matter it appears to the satisfaction of the Court that the character of the Defendant and the circumstances of the case are such that he is not likely again to engage in an offensive course of conduct, and the public good does not demand or require that he be immediately sentenced; therefore, the imposition of sentence on said Defendant consisting of a fine of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars and costs and one (1) year in the Mahoning County jail is hereby suspended, and he is placed on probation in the manner provided by law, upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Good behavior.
2. No further association with individuals which might cause him to violate the terms and conditions of this probation.
3. Continued psychiatric treatment until discharged by the medical personnel rendering such treatment.
4. That he report promptly each work day at 9:00 o'clock A.M. and continue to perform a full day's work consistent with his physical ability.
5. That he serve one weekend in the Mahoning County jail commencing on Friday evening *April, 28* 1967, and ending Sunday *April, 30* 1967, at 7:00 o'clock P.M.
6. The fine assessed shall be paid by the Defendant within the next sixty (60) days.

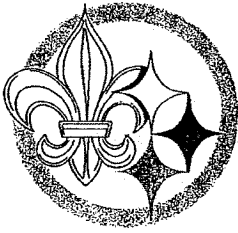

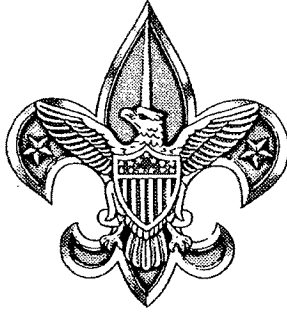
