I had some previous correspondence with Howard Boyd regarding one Robert P. Lewis. This man was evidently involved in immoral acts with six boys enroute back from Philmont in 1967.

The matter was brought before the Quincy Police; but for some unexplainable reasons, legal charges were not pressed.

In an interview with Police Chief Francis Finn of Quincy, it is his feeling that since the immoral acts took place outside of the State, interstate prosecution would have been very difficult.

Lewis was asked to resign from the Quincy School System and from the Troop.

Regardless, he should have been placed on the Confidential File two years ago. I am, therefore, requesting that you immediately do so. Unfortunately, I have no further information other than that on the attached sheet.
