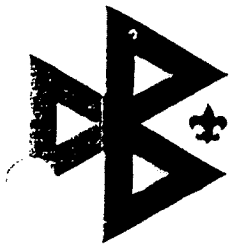

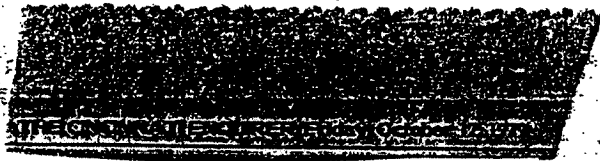

**Scout Leader  
Faces Charges**

UNCLE SAM WIFE - the leader  
of a Scout troop here appeared  
in Hamilton County Municipal  
Court on two counts each  
of gross sexual imposition  
and indecent exposure to the Hamilton  
County grand jury. The charges  
were filed against the leader  
of the Seven Hills area, who  
was on bond following the  
arrest of the leader for gross  
sexual imposition with having sexual  
intercourse with three members of  
the Scout troop here and with  
a young boy, said Police Chief  
[Name].

under a section of Ohio law that de-  
scribes sexual contact with a  
child under 16 years of age.

# Cub Scout leader charged in rapes

A Springfield Township Cub Scout leader was in court this morning on charges that he raped and sexually assaulted young boys in his community.

Robert W. Cooke, 45, of 11665 Silverbrook Drive, was bound over to the Hamilton County grand jury on two charges of rape and two charges of gross sexual imposition.

Cooke is a staff supervisor for Cincinnati Bell and heads a church-affiliated scout troop. Timothy Hogan, senior assistant prosecutor for the City of Cincinnati, said the offenses involved three 8-year-old Cub Scouts and a 15-year-old boy. Hogan said the offenses occurred July 15 and Aug. 11. The gross sexual impositions, Hogan said, occurred Sept. 15 and Oct. 1.

Each offense occurred in Cooke's home, garage or in a wooded area nearby, Hogan said.

Hogan denied Hogan's request for a high bond and ordered Cooke held in lieu of \$4,000 - \$1,000 for each offense. Hogan asked for a higher bond because of a serious sanity issue.

Springfield Township Police Officer Robert C. Dotz testified that an investigation began Oct. 6 after the parents of some of the children in Cooke's troop filed complaints. Dotz said that investigation is continuing. Hogan, who is employed by the City of Cincinnati, is prosecuting the Springfield Township case because he is assigned to the county-wide Mayor's Offender Program.
