

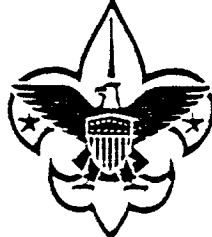

Dear Paul:

Enclosed are two forms - an Ineligible Volunteer Record Sheet and a Suspected Child Abuse Reporting Form for Robert W. McAnally. Mr. McAnally is out on bail on four charges (two charges of child abuse and two for sexual assault on a child - one charge each for the periods of 1980-81 and 1989.) Mr. McAnally was arraigned yesterday and is set for appearance of counsel and demand for preliminary hearing on May 30th. His preliminary hearing should be approximately thirty days later.

Mr. McAnally resigned as Scoutmaster of Troop 636 on May 11th and on May 16th called me to inform me that in no way was he involved with any Scouts. I informed him a letter stating his suspension from the Boy Scouts was being mailed that day. Enclosed is a copy. Would you please add Mr. McAnally to your confidential record file and delete his name from your registration file.

Thank you. I'll keep you posted on the outcome of the case.

Dear Robert:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that B.S.A. membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership the B.S.A. seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a B.S.A. Regional Review Committee, please write to the Regional Director within sixty days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a B.S.A. member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are enclosed.
