# Scoutmaster admits guilt in sex case

A former assistant scoutmaster who pleaded guilty to charges of sexually assaulting two boys in Ottawa and Muskegon counties has pleaded guilty to fondling another boy in Allegan County.

Robert Walter Gleason II, 27, of Jenison, pleaded guilty in Allegan County Circuit Court to second-degree criminal sexual conduct against a 12-year-old Wyoming boy while on an April 1990 Boy Scout outing near Otsego.

The felony charge carries a max-

imum sentence of 15 years in prison. Allegan County Assistant Prosecutor Margaret Zuzich Bakker said. Gleason is to be sentenced Jan. 3 by Allegan County Circuit Judge George Corsiglia.

In exchange for the plea Friday, a first-degree criminal sexual conduct charge against Gleason was dropped, Bakker said.

"The reasoning is that he has been sentenced to more serious charges in other counties and this would not affect his sentence at all and there was no reason to go to trial," Bakker said.

Gleason was sentenced to 15-50 years in prison in October by Ottawa County Circuit Judge Wesley

Nykamp after pleading guilty to first-degree criminal sexual conduct against a 5-year-old boy. Gleason also was sentenced in October to 4-15 years in prison in Muskegon County Circuit Court for fondling an 11-year-old boy during a Boy Scout outing in Muskegon County last May.

Gleason is expected to serve the prison sentences concurrently, Bakker said.

Bakker said she is pleased Gleason's case did not go to trial.

"I'm glad that the victim didn't have to testify," she said.

Attempts to reach Gleason's attorney, Fred R. Hunter III of Allegan, were unsuccessful Tuesday.

# Ex-Scout leader gets term of 15-50

OTTAWA COUNTY

A Jenison man already sentenced for fondling one young boy in Muskegon and facing similar charges in Allegan County was sentenced to 15 to 50 years in prison Monday for raping a 5-year-old boy last December in Ottawa County.

Robert Walter Gleason II, 27, 7295 East Lane St., showed little emotion as he was sentenced by Ottawa Circuit Court Judge Wesley Nykamp on the first-degree criminal sexual conduct charge.

Gleason, a former assistant scoutmaster with a Jenison Boy Scout troop, pleaded guilty to the charge last month after a three-county investigation also led to a guilty plea on second-degree criminal sexual conduct in Muskegon County and charges of first- and second-degree criminal sexual conduct in Allegan County.

A veteran of the U.S. Navy and an honor roll student at Grand Valley State University, Gleason told Nykamp he pleaded guilty "for quite a few reasons."

Nykamp said he understood Gleason "expressed remorse" for his actions, but added he had to be more concerned about the welfare of Gleason's victims.

"The court has to consider the tragic effects of the actions that were suffered by the victims involved with you," Nykamp said. "The purpose of this sentence has to be punishment."

Defense attorney James Piper pleaded for Nykamp to consider Gleason's cooperation in working with authorities, saying Gleason was "as honest and has made as much effort to make things right more than any other client I have represented."

"This is a very tragic occurrence for this young man," Piper said. "This young man has a lot to offer society and just to lock him up and put him away I don't think helps him or society."

Ottawa County Chief Assistant Prosecutor Douglas Mesman called the sentence "appropriate," indicating Gleason should not receive leniency despite his service in the Navy and the Boy Scouts.

"You are talking about a 27-year-old man and a 5-year-old child and this man was referred to as 'Uncle Bob' by the family," Mesman said.

Gleason was lodged in Ottawa County Jail following the sentencing.

The Muskegon and Allegan

county charges stem from incidents that took place while he was an assistant scoutmaster with the Jenison-based Troop 354 of the Boy Scouts of America. He had worked with the troop since January 1989.

Gleason was arrested in June on charges that he fondled an 11-year Boy Scout who accompanied him on a trip to Muskegon County to assist with a Scout outing May 31 to June 1. He faced charges in Ottawa County in the same incident, but those charges were dropped as part of the plea bargain.

Following his arrest, authorities received further allegations that Gleason had assaulted at least three other young boys ranging in age from 5 to 12. Authorities agreed to prosecute the most serious charges in each county in exchange for Gleason's cooperation to identify and seek treatment for other alleged victims.

Gleason was sentenced last Thursday to four to 15 years in prison on the Muskegon County charge. He has been bound over to Allegan County Circuit Court on charges there.

# Boy Scout leader receives prison term for youth sex assault

MUSKEGON — A Jenison Boy Scout leader who admitted to fondling an 11-year-old boy in his care at Muskegon County's Gerber Scout Reservation was sentenced Thursday to serve between four and 15 years in prison for second-degree criminal sexual conduct.

Robert Walter Gleason II, 27, 7295 East Lane St., showed no emotion as 14th Circuit Judge R. Max Daniels lectured him on the Boy Scout motto's lesson in trustworthiness and sentenced him to the prison term.

"You've violated that trustworthiness. You've taken children in your charge ... and you've used them for your own sexual pleasures," Daniels said.

"I don't believe you should ever be placed in a (similar) position of trust," Daniels said. "Children are too important."

Gleason was sexually abused as a child, Daniels noted, and urged prison officials to offer him psychological counseling — either at the Riverside Correctional Facility in Ionia or at another institution.

Gleason, an assistant scoutmaster with Jenison's Troop 354 since 1989, also faces felony sex charges in Ottawa and Allegan counties. He was dismissed from his Boy Scout position in June when he was

charged.

A U.S. Navy veteran who had been a junior at Grand Valley State University, Gleason has pleaded guilty to first-degree criminal sexual conduct in Ottawa County and will be sentenced in Grand Haven on Monday.

Charges and pleas in all three counties were coordinated in a three-way plea arrangement.

In the Ottawa case, Gleason admitted assaulting a sleeping 5-year-old boy on Dec. 21. In exchange for that plea, Ottawa County authorities dropped two other first-degree charges and one second-degree sex charge involving two other boys, 6 and 9, as well as the Scout. Gleason remains

in the Ottawa County jail.

Earlier, Gleason was bound over on Wednesday for trial in Allegan County Circuit Court on charges of first- and second-degree criminal sexual conduct. He is charged with fondling and raping a 12-year-old Boy Scout of Troop 354 while the group was on a 1990 camping trip.

The offense charged in Muskegon and one of the Ottawa charges involve the same youth and occurred between May 31 and June 1. The Georgetown Township boy told his parents Gleason fondled him three times during the weekend scouting trip.

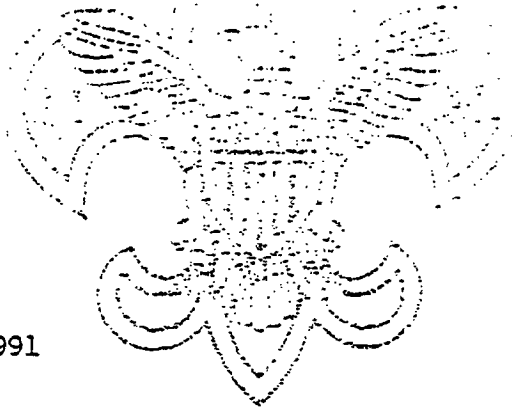

# Scoutmaster faces charges that he fondled Scout, 11

The arrest of an assistant Scoutmaster for allegedly fondling an 11-year-old Boy Scout during a weekend camping trip is like a bad dream, the head of the Jenison troop said Monday.

"I think if I wake up next week, I'll think, 'Did this thing ever really happen? That it was all a dream?'" said Jerry Fish, head Scoutmaster of Troop 354 since 1986.

Robert "Bud" Gleason II, 27, of 7295 East Lane St. in Jenison, was arraigned Monday on one count of second-degree criminal sexual conduct in Ottawa County District Court in Grand Haven.

He was arrested at his home Sunday by sheriff's deputies after the boy's parents reported their son told them he was fondled on several occasions by Gleason during an outing that weekend.

Gleason was released on \$3,000 personal recognizance bond. A

preliminary hearing was set for June 11 by District Judge Richard Kloote. The charge carries a maximum 15-year sentence.

Gleason had been an assistant Scoutmaster since January 1989. He belonged to the same troop as a Scout until he graduated from high school and entered the Navy, Fish said.

"Bud is very well-known in this community and is a member of our sponsoring organization (the local Knights of Columbus chapter)," Fish said, adding Gleason is a Grand Valley State University student and made the Dean's List last term.

"The boys liked him and he worked well with them," Fish said. "He was the youngest adult leader and consequently the boys looked up to him."

Attempts to reach Gleason for comment Monday were unsuccessful. Authorities say he has no known criminal record.

Gleason picked the boy up Friday evening and drove him to Camp Gerber in northern Muskegon County, a 790-acre Boy Scout camp, said Ottawa Detective Del South.

Three Boy Scouts and two adult troop leaders — including Gleason and the alleged victim — assisted about 50 members of a Jenison Cub Scout pack holding a weekend camping trip.

The boy claimed Gleason fondled him on three occasions during the weekend, the first allegedly occurring late Saturday or early Sunday in a tent where Gleason and the boy were sleeping with the other three troop members.

South said the boy claimed he also was fondled by Gleason two other times — during the car ride back to Jenison and afterward at Gleason's home, both Sunday afternoon.

South said he is to speak with

Muskegon County authorities involving possible charges in their jurisdiction from the alleged incidents.

South said Gleason and the boy drove up alone together because they were unable to travel with the rest of the troop for some reason.

Boy Scout officials say that is an apparent violation of national Boy Scouts of America (BSA) policy. Paul Bongiovanni, spokesman for the West Michigan Shores Council of the BSA, said the organization's guidelines require at least two

adults be present when Scouts are on an outing or at a meeting.

"The policy was initiated several years ago as part of our youth protection guidelines," Bongiovanni said. "It's not only for proper leadership, but also to guard against those people who might have abusive tendencies."

Gleason has been suspended from all troop activities while charges are pending, Bongiovanni added.

South said he, Fish and other troop leaders met with about 40 parents Monday night at Bauerwood Elementary School in Jenison, where Troop 354 was holding a regularly scheduled awards pro-

gram. "Many of the parents were very supportive of (Gleason)," South said. "They said they were surprised."

South said he asked the parents to talk with their children to find out if they had any knowledge of similar activity.

"We explained that we were interested in knowing if anything had happened and that they should talk to their kids," South said.

# a defendant pleads guilty to CSC

Lopez, who is free on a \$5,000 personal recognizance bond, faces up to 15 years in prison when sentenced on Sept. 16.

"The DNA tests were 99.9 percent sure that he and nobody else was the father of the fetus the victim carried," said Babbitt, who describes DNA testing as an important new tool in proving who committed a crime.

In one of the cases the abortion was medically necessary. In the other, the alleged victim elected to have an abortion.

DNA is shorthand for deoxyribonucleic acid, the molecule holding genetic codes that determine each person's characteristics.

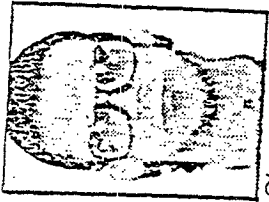
The genetics laboratory isolates DNA from samples taken from the fetus and the girl's blood, and compares them with DNA in a blood sample from the accused. Authorities believe that the method can rule out up to 99 percent of the male population as having been responsible for the pregnancy.

# Former Jenison Scout aide faces new, more serious sex charge

A Boy Scout leader charged with fondling an 11-year-old boy during a camping trip earlier this year faces a new, more serious sex charge involving an outing in Allegan County last year.



Robert Walter Gleason II, formerly an assistant scoutmaster in Jenison, was arraigned in Allegan County District Court on one count of first- and second-degree criminal sexual conduct in connection with the April 1990 outing.

St. in Jenison, is free on a \$5,000 personal recognizance bond.

Authorities charge he fondled and raped the 12-year-old boy, a member of the Boy Scout Troop 354 on a camping trip at the Moose Lodge Campground near Otsego.

The boy, who has since moved to the Muskegon area, told a social worker about the incident recently, who then reported the incident to detectives in the Muskegon Police Department, said Ottawa County Detective Del South. South investigated, then turned his findings over to Allegan County authorities.

"The young man advised (Gleason) that he didn't like the boys that he was going to sleep with and asked if could spend the night in another tent," said South, who said there were 12 boys and four Scout leaders on the April 20 outing. "I don't think the other leaders knew what was going on."

If convicted on the Allegan and Ottawa counties carry a maxi-

imum life sentence on the first-degree charge and up to 15 years on the second-degree charge. He was arraigned Aug. 1 and an Oct. 30 preliminary hearing has been set.

In June, Gleason was arraigned in Ottawa and Muskegon counties on two second-degree sex charges stemming from an incident involving an 11-year-old Jenison boy that occurred the weekend of May 31-June 2 at a camp in northern Muskegon County.

Gleason allegedly fondled the boy while traveling from a Cub Scout campout in Muskegon County where five members of Troop 354 and three troop leaders assisted. Authorities also claim Gleason fondled the boy at Gleason's home.

He was ordered to trial in both counties and released on personal recognizance bonds.

Each of the charges in Muskegon and Ottawa counties carry a maxi-

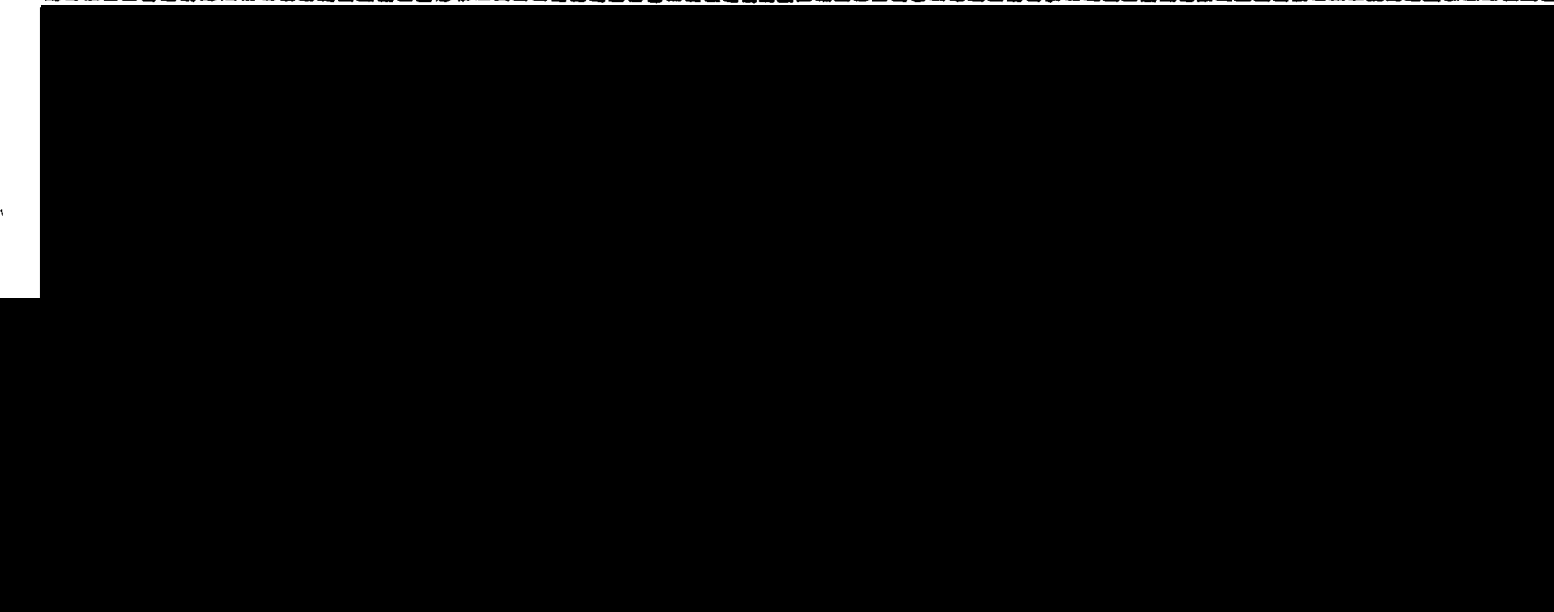

WE BEGAN THE INTERVIEW BY ASKING THE VICTIM WHERE HE WENT THIS WEEKEND. HE STATED THAT HE WAS PICKED UP AT SANDY HILL ELEMENTARY AT AROUND 1830 HRS ON FRIDAY NIGHT. THE SUSPECT INSTRUCTED HIM TO GET INTO HIS VEHICLE FOR THE RIDE UP TO CAMP GERBER WHERE THE CAMP OUTING WAS TAKING PLACE. HE STATED ONCE THEY GOT UP THERE THEY PITCHED A TENT ABOUT 50 YARDS AWAY FROM THE CABINS THAT THE CUB SCOUTS WERE STAYING IN. HE STATED THAT THE FIRST INCIDENT HAPPENED IN THE TENT ON FRIDAY OR SATURDAY HE COULD NOT REMEMBER. WHEN ASKED WHAT HAPPENED, THE VICTIM STATED THAT THE OTHER PEOPLE IN THE TENT WERE GONE AND WHILE HE WAS ALONE WITH THE SUSPECT, THE SUSPECT DID SOME "WIERD THINGS" TO HIM. WHEN ASKED TO GET SPECIFIC, THE VICTIM STATED THAT SUSPECT PUT HIS HAND ON HIS PENIS AND WAS RUBBING THE PENIS WITH HIS HAND. I ASKED IF HE WAS RUBBING OVER THE TOP OF HIS CLOTHES OR UNDER AND THE VICTIM STATED UNDER. THE VICTIM ALSO STATED THAT THE SUSPECT NEVER HAD THE VICTIM TOUCH HIM ANYWHERE. THE VICTIM ALSO STATED THAT THE SUSPECT DID NOT PUT THE VICTIM'S PENIS IN HIS MOUTH, THAT THE SUSPECT ONLY RUBBED THE VICTIM'S PENIS WITH HIS HAND, ON TOP OF THE CLOTHES. THE VICTIM WAS ASKED IF THE INCIDENT HAPPENED MORE THAN ONCE AT THE CAMP AND HE SAID HE WAS NOT SURE IF IT WAS ONCE OR TWICE.

THE VICTIM WAS THEN ASKED IF THE SUSPECT TOUCHED HIM AT ANY OTHER TIME THIS WEEKEND AND HE STATED THAT YES THE ON THE WAY HOME HE WAS NOT FEELING GOOD SO HE LAYED DOWN ON THE FRONT SEAT. HE STATED THAT THE SUSPECT REACHED OVER AND PUT HIS HAND ON THE VICIM'S PENIS, AND RUBBED IT LIKE BEFORE AT THE CAMP. HE WAS ASKED AGAIN IF THE CONTACT WAS OVER OR UNDER THE SHORTS HE STATED THAT ONE TIME THE SUSPECT REACHED UNDER HIS SHORTS AND RUBBED THE PENIS. WE ASKED THE VICTIM IF HE UNDERSTOOD WHAT AN ERECTION WAS AND HE RESPONDED NO. DEP. BROWER THEN EXPLAINED WHAT AN ERECTION WAS AND ASKED THE VICTIM IF HE HAD AN ERECTION WHEN THE SUSPECT WAS TOUCHING HIM IN THE CAR. THE VICTIM STATED THAT HE REALLY DID NOT KNOW WHETHER HE HAD AN ERECTION OR NOT.

WE THEN ASKED IF THERE WAS ANOTHER TIME THIS OCCURRED, THE VICTIM STATED THAT THEY STOPPED AT THE SUSPECT'S HOUSE TO GET SOME CARVING TOOLS HE WANTED TO BORROW. THE VICTIM STATED THAT WHILE HE WAS IN THE HOUSE THE SUSPECT AND HIM WENT DOWNSTAIRS IN THE BASEMENT. WHEN ASKED WHAT HAPPENED DOWN IN THE BASEMENT THE VICTIM REPLIED THAT HE SAT DOWN ON THE WATERBED AND FELL OVER ON HIS BACK. HE STATED THAT THE SUSPECT THEN STARTED RUBBING HIS PENIS OVER HIS SHORTS AS WELL AS UNDER HIS SHORTS. WHEN ASKED IF THE SUSPECT EVER PULLED DOWN HIS PANTS THE VICTIM ANSWERED YES AT THE HOUSE. THE VICTIM WAS ASKED IF THE SUSPECT SAID ANYTHING WHILE THIS WAS GOING ON OR IF HE WAS THREATENED IN ANY WAY. THE VICTIM SAID THAT HE WAS NOT THREATNED BUT THAT THE SUSPECT TOLD HIM NOT TO BE NERVOUS THAT NOBODY WILL KNOW, AND HE WOULDN'T TELL. THE VICTIM STATED THAT HE GOT SICK AND VOMITED WHILE IN THE BASEMENT AFTER THE INCIDENT OCCURRED. THE VICTIM ALSO STATED THAT BEFORE HE WAS TAKEN HOME, THE SUSPECT GAVE HIM A SET OF BASEBALL CARD OF THE '83 TIGERS. WHEN ASKED IF HE HAD AN ERECTION AT THE SUSPECT'S HOUSE HE SAID HE DID NOT KNOW IF HE DID. WHEN ASKED IF HE WAS ASKED TO TOUCH THE SUSPECT ANYWHERE, THE VICTIM STATED NO. THE VICTIM WAS ASKED IF HE WAS AWARE OF ANY OTHER BOYS WHO THIS HAS HAPPENED TO, AND HE REPLIED NO.

DEP. MCDIARMID AND I ORIGINALLY WENT TO THE [REDACTED] ADDRESS LISTED IN THE PHONE BOOK FOR A [REDACTED] LIVING IN THE JENISON AREA. UPON ARRIVAL, WE SPOKE WITH THE LADY OF THE HOUSE WHO STATED THAT "BUD" GLEASON WAS HER SON. SHE SAID THAT HE WAS NOT HOME, THAT HE WAS ON A BOY SCOUT CAMPOUT AND NOT DUE BACK UNTIL LATE IN THE AFTERNOON. SHE ALSO STATED THAT HE WAS PRESENTLY LIVING WITH HIS SISTER AT [REDACTED].

WE WENT TO THE [REDACTED] ADDRESS AND LOCATED ROBERT (BUD) GLEASON. WE ASKED HIM TO STEP TO THE CRUISER TO TALK ABOUT THIS INCIDENT.

AFTER PLACING HIM IN THE CRUISER, DEP. MCDIARMID READ HIM THE MIRANDA RIGHTS VI THE MIRANDA WARNING CARD. BUD STATED THAT HE UNDERSTOOD AND WOULD ANSWER OUR QUESTIONS. HE SAID SOMETHING ABOUT WONDERING IF HE NEEDED AN ATTORNEY. I ADVISE HIM THAT HE COULD GET AN ATTORNEY IF HE WISHED AND THAT HE COULD REFUSE TO ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS AT ANY TIME. I THEN ASKED IF HE STILL WANTED TO ANSWER MY QUESTIONS AT THIS TIME. HE STATED HE DID.

BUD STATES THAT DURING ONE OF THE EVENINGS (EITHER FRIDAY NIGHT OR SATURDAY NIGHT) HE REACHED OVER AND FONDLED [REDACTED] PENIS OVER TOP OF [REDACTED] CLOTHING. HE SAYS HE RUBBED HIS HAND OVER [REDACTED] GROIN AREA FOR A FEW MINUTES BUT STOPPED BECAUSE HE DIDN'T WANT TO WAKE UP [REDACTED] OR [REDACTED].
