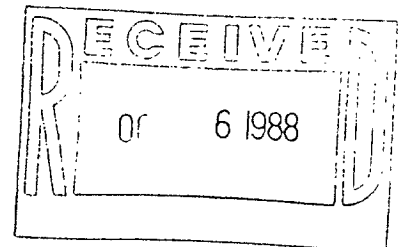

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of membership the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for review are attached.

On December 22, 1987 District Scout Executive Charlie Furlough and I met with Rod Hensch. The purpose of the meeting was to hand deliver a letter to Rod stating that his registration with the BSA has been suspended.

We made sure that Rod understood that Scouting was not making judgement on his guilt or innocence.

Rod said that he would comply with the letter until such time that he could be reinstated.

Grand jury to hear fondling case against Lancaster substitute teacher

LANCASTER — A Dallas County grand jury is scheduled next week to hear the case against a Lancaster substitute teacher charged with four counts of indecency with a child.

Rodney Earl Hensch, 36, of Dallas, was arrested Dec. 17 on the second-degree felony charges after four students at Houston Elementary in Lancaster complained that Hensch had touched them improperly, police said.

Hensch, also a cubmaster of a Cud Scout pack in Lancaster and pastor of the 25-member Concord Freewill Church in South Dallas, said he is innocent and intends to testify before the grand jury on Tuesday.

"I was shocked that it even came about," said Hensch, who is free on \$10,000 bond. "I've never been accused of anything like this before. The whole thing is just impossible to me."

Hensch was teaching a third-grade class at Houston Elementary on Dec. 9 when the incidents allegedly occurred, police said. He was arrested after the students and their parents filed complaints with the Lancaster Police Department.

Hensch, a substitute teacher in the Lancaster Independent School District for the last 3 1/2 years, has been suspended from the substitute list since being charged, said Katherine Oates, school district administrative assistant. Police would not give details of the incidents that led to the

charges, and they withheld the names of the complainants' families to protect the identity of the juveniles involved.

But a parent of one of the children said she believes Hensch fondled her child. "They (supporters of Hensch) said he just patted them on the bottom. But it's more serious than that," she said.

Capt. J.E. Feenster, head of the criminal investigation division, said police decided to arrest Hensch after taking the complaints from two girls, ages 9 and 10, and two 9-year-old boys.

The Child Protective Services division of the Texas Department of Human Services helped police with the interviews, said Human Services spokeswoman Barbara Johnson.

Hensch said he does not know what students are responsible for the charges, although he is acquainted with many students in the Lancaster school system, where he has taught elementary through high school classes.

On Dec. 9, he said, he worked a half-day as a substitute teacher for a third-grade class of about 30 pupils but had little direct contact with the children.

"Most of what we did was board work, where I was at the board teaching and they were in their seats," he said.

"I might have put a hand on the shoulder of a kid who was having trouble to show them how to do something. But that's it." Hensch, registered as a cubmas-

ter of a pack sponsored by Houston Elementary and an assistant Boy Scout troopmaster for the last four years, has been suspended from those duties, said William Gamble, executive director of the Dallas-area Circle Ten Council of the Boy Scouts of America.

Suspension is automatic whenever a Scout leader is charged with this type of offense, and Hensch could be reinstated if found innocent, Gamble said.

"From the reports we've had, we do know that for the past four years the parents and Scout leaders have been real high on him," Gamble said.

Hensch said he was a Boy Scout when growing up in New Jersey and has worked with the Scouts for

20 years. He has lived in Dallas for the last 10 years and served as pastor of the small Baptist church for nine years, and he supports himself with regular substitute teaching assignments, he said.

Friends and fellow Scout leaders helped raise money for Hensch's bond and have offered moral support, said John Gary, a Lancaster scoutmaster.

"Everyone that knows him in the pack, in the Scout troop and in the school district are very supportive," said Gary, adding that one of his sons had been in Hensch's cub pack.

"Any of the allegations would have had to take place in a classroom atmosphere," Gary said, "and that's just ludicrous."

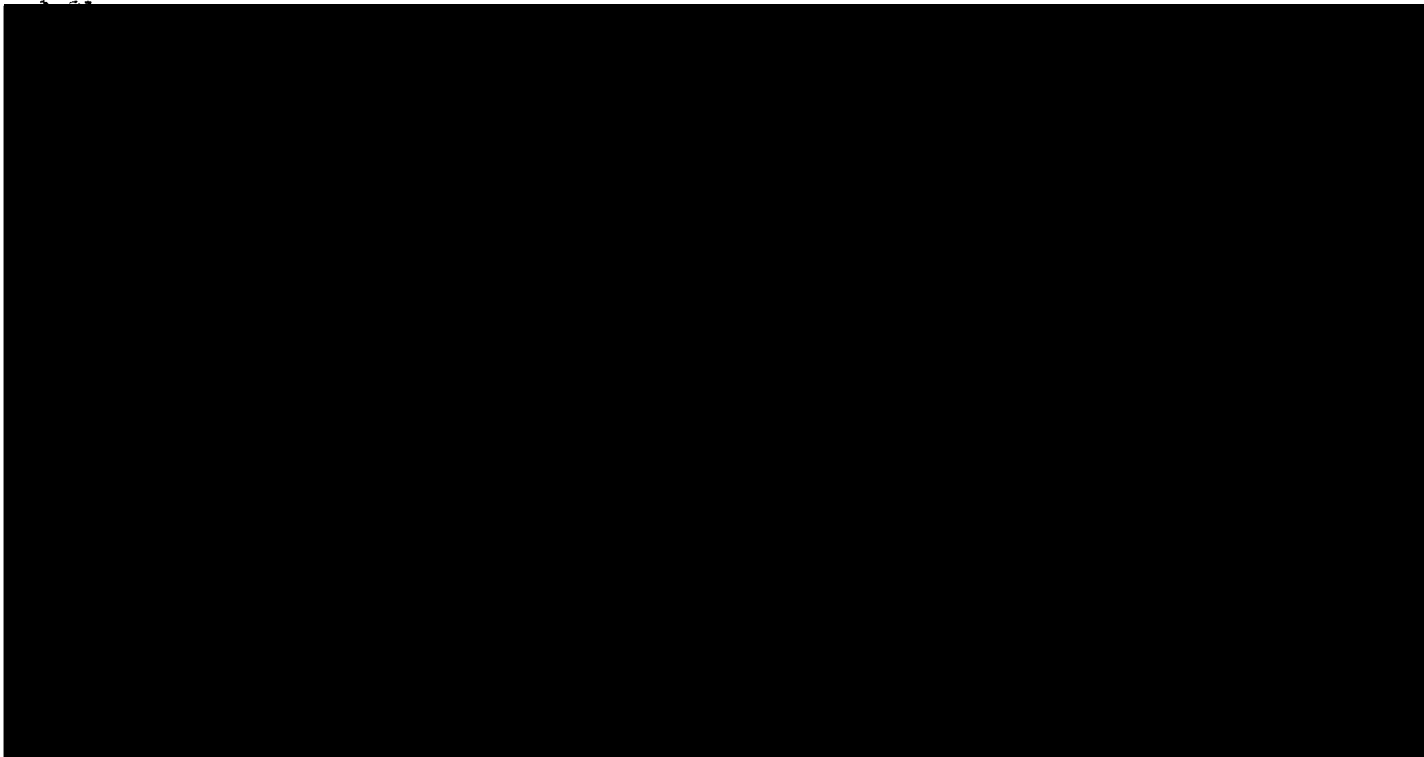
