We wanted to make you aware of this, so you would not involve him. Let us know if you have any questions.



### Gentlemen;

Upon returning home from college for Thanksgiving break, I learned that my request for an extension to obtain my Eagle had been denied. It is at this time that I would like to formally appeal this decision.

Prior to my registration with Troop 676 I was a part of Troop 622. On October 1, 1987 a letter was received stating that the family was going to be dropped from the troop (enclosed). The reason for this was "Some basic differences between you (my father), your family, and the majority of the members of Penascouting regarding the appropriate means of attaining the aims of boy scouting in Troop 622 have surfaced in recent months."

The time between being kicked out of Troop 622 and my joining Troop 676 was two full years. This new troop was approximately six months into existence and I spent most of my time with this troop helping it get off and running and, not quite realizing it, my pursuit for Eagle was placed under the rug for some time.

Since being kicked out of Troop 622, the former Scoutmaster, Rodney F. Stark, has been sentenced to 16 years in prison for the sexual molestation of a member of the troop. This molestation was during our tenure with the troop.

The reason for my not bringing this to your attention the first time I requested an extension was because we were hoping to put a very traumatic experience behind us. To sum up all the events: my family and I were ousted from Troop 622 in October of 1987, I was out of Scouting for a period of two years, I joined a new troop in 1989 and helped build that, in 1990 my previous Scoutmaster was convicted of the sexual molestation of one of the scouts in his troop, and to top all this off, our family was relatively close to the family whose sons were molested.

In addition, my father had requested that I not bring this up, as we had agreed that I was going to become an Eagle in spite of Rod's worst intentions towards our family as a whole. At the time of our ouster, my father was an Assistant Scoutmaster, my brother was a Tenderfoot and my youngest brother was just graduating from Weblos.

,

The ousting of parent association, as the letter would lead you to believe. It was typed on Rod's computer and signed by the Scouting Coordinator. This was after my father had offered to drop out of any activity in the troop. This offer was spurned by Rod, as he did not want any of the family to remain in the troop. There was no "trial" nor discussion provided. To add insult to injury, it was typed on stationary my father had obtained for the troop from one of his clients.

The basic differences were between my father and Rod, in that Rod felt very threatened by the financial success my father had organized the troop Firewood Sale into. Rod felt that my dad was "running for Scoutmaster" and therefore his "power base" was being threatened. This was during the time that the molestation was going on, not only with the current victim, but also with boys that charges could not be brought against Rod due to the statute of limitations having expired.

The dismissal from the troop was brought up with local council staff and they felt that Rod was too powerful in that troop to offer any resistance to our removal; after all he had been Scoutmaster for 17 years. Instead my father was encouraged to start a new troop. It was never my father's intentions to become Scoutmaster or start a new troop. He was very happy running the fund raising operation of a troop with 76 Scouts and provide an avenue for the families to raise the funds to underwrite Scouting activities. After all, there was 3 of us in the troop with my youngest brother just joining, so funding the activities was a concern for us too.

As outlined in the appeal information I received, I feel that part of the bottom line of my not fulfilling the Eagle requirements timely was "due to circumstances beyond my control." Therefore, I would like to request an appeal to your decision based on the above accounts.

If you feel you need additional information, you may Mr. Len Lanzi at San Diego Headquarters or my father can offer you names and phone numbers to verify the above information. As stated in my previous extension request, I would like it to run through January 31, 1991.

Dear Richard;

Since the membership in Troop 622 of my entire family was terminated, by Rod Stark thru Bill Heinrich effective i October 1987, I felt it best to put into writing several phone calls between Rod Stark, Larry Cleeton and myself concerning the 10 cords of firewood delivered by Troop 669 to your wood lot.

As lot mamanger for Troop 622's woodsale I am directing this letter to you to clarify these conversations.

On 29 September 1987 I was informed by Rod that the reason for the total depletion of my sons monies from their woodsale accounts was the delivery of 10 cords of firewood by the Escondido troep. Rod stated to me that the delivery was without the permission of the parent committee and that I was responsible for that wood. Therefore, on his own, he charged the cost to the boys accounts. Rod further informed me that the wood was now mine and that I could dispose of it as I saw fit since it was now paid for.

Based on several conversations with Larry Cleeton it was agreed that the 10 cords of wood, that was improperly delivered thru an original agreement between myself and the Escondido troop, was in fact now my wood. Unfortunately, over Labor Day weekend my in fact now my wood. Unfortunately, over Labor Day weekend my National Guard unit was activated for the northern California fires and the phone call to cancel the furture deliveries was forgotten. This was my responsibility to make.

On 4 October 1987 I contacted Rcd concerning the disposal of this wood. We agreed that the 10 cords of avocado firewood would be picked up according to your desires as lot manager for the woodsale. It was further agreed that it didn't matter what stack of wood was to be "attacked" as long as no more than 10 cords of wood was removed from your lot.

Due to a LDS Scout training seminar on 17 October 1987 the LDS troop I had contacted was not able to pick up any wood. I have informed them of your next delivery date of 21 November and they will work with that.

As soon as I know a cord count I will contact you regarding swood pick up.

A Rancho Penasquitos neighborhood is in shock tonight over the arrest of a man who was both a school teacher and a Scoutmaster to their children. He's accused of child molestation. Vic Salazar is here now with more on that story. Vic?

Well, Denise, this is a very sensitive story as you can well imagine. It deals with a fourteen-year-old Boy Scout who has accused his Scoutmaster of molesting him. Tonight that Scoutmaster is multy jail charged with five counts of loral sex with youngster under fourteen, and five counts of lewd and lastivious acts with a minor. Forty-one-year-old Rodney Scale has been a Scoutmaster for twenty years. (Visual of Black Mountain Middle School sign) He is also a sixth grade teacher at Black Mountain Middle School, which is where his Troop, number 622, is based. (Visual of Stark home) Friday night he was arrested here at his home just a short distance from the school. A fourteen-year-old boy in Stark's troop told authorities Stark had molested him on several occasions during the last three years while on organized camping trips. Tonight, one of Stark's students who is also a troop member told me he considers Stark to be a nice guy.

Salazar: mother expressed a view shared by many others tonight.

(Scout's mother): It's a terrible shock and we really hope that it's not -- that there's no truth to any of the allegations, for everyone's sake, and I'm praying for Mister Stark tonight and I have a lot of friends who will be too.

Salazar: Rodney Stark will be arraigned tomorrow morning.

His bail has been set at two hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars.

Yamada: Now I understand, Vic, that the school has moved in a substitute to teach. What about the troop? What are they doing now? Do they have a leader?

Salazar: They don't have a leader as of this moment. Mister Stark has been relieved of his Scoutmaster duties by the local Boy Scout Council. Now tomorrow night there is a troop meeting, and the Parents' Council will meet to choose a new Scoutmaster for Troop 622.

Yamada: Alright. Thanks very much.

### **Teacher** convicted of child molesting

A Rancho Peñasquitos scoutmaster and teacher was convicted yesterday of 12 sex charges involving one of his troop members.

A Superior Court jury of 10 women. and two men deliberated about a day before convicting Rodney Fred Stark, 41, of eight counts of child molesting and four counts of oral copulation of a minor.

Stark faces a maximum of 22: years in state prison.

The jury also found true a special allegation that Stark occupied a special position of trust in committing the crimes against the boy, now 14.

The finding, according to Deputy District Attorney Sally J. Penso, makes Stark ineligible for probation when he is sentenced Aug. 31 by Superior Court Judge Laura P. Hammes. The judge ordered Stark to remain in custody, with no bail, until he is sentenced.

Stark has been on a leave of absence from his job as a sixth-grade teacher at Black Mountain Middle School in the Poway Unified School District since his arrest in March.

Yesterday, Stark, who has been active in the Boy Scout program for 29 years, and directed what he termed one of the largest scout troops in the county, touched hands with his attorney Lane Cooke as the jurors took their seats.

Then he sat impassively as court cierk Holly Saenz read each of the 12 guilty verdicts and each of the special allegations.

Several of his supporters, who have attended each court session, began to weep. After Hammes ordered Stark into custody, and as the bailiff began putting handcuffs:on him, some supporters gasped, then rushed out of the courtroom, sobbing.

The jury found Stark committed the 12 acts during a three-year peri-od ending last February on scouting. trips to Camp Hual-Cu-Cuish in the Julian area. The acts also occurred during the summer of 1988 at Camp Mataguay, during a two-night campout at Indian Flats and another. camp-out at the Crestline Group Camp near Mt. Palomar.

The jury also found that offenses were committed during a four-wheel vehicle trip to the eastern desert area last December.

The victim was not present to hear the verdict, but his parents expressed relief that the ordeal for their son was over.
