

Suspect had been a Scout Leader of Troop 741, Crystal Lake Elementary School when this crime against nature had taken place between the Christmas holidays of 1969 and until the end of April, 1970.

Mr. Dickinson, the suspect, left Troop 741 in the summer of 1970 and went to work around Port Myers, Plorida, returned this fall and applied for and took Bouth Florida Ave., Lakeland, Florida. over Troop 727 at the Methodist Temple, At the time he applied for the Scout Master's job, he inquired of Mr. Austin M. Sutton, District Scout Executive, "Have you heard any rumors about me while I was gone this summer?" Fir. Sutton told him no, as he had heard no rumors until the past two weeks that something was wrong and the parents that had called would not state what they were driving at, but that Mr. Dickinson should be removed as a Scout Master or Leader and not be allowed to have any contact with young boys any more




