Man Faces Morals Count

MICHIGAN CITY — A North Judson man will appear in city court here tomorrow to face charges stemming from alleged advances yesterday to a 15-year-old boy.

Ronald F. Golding, 35, is charged with contributing to the delinquency of a minor. He was apprehended last night at the Michigan City city limits after leading police on a high-speed chase.

According to police, the boy said he was hitchhiking along Franklin street yesterday afternoon when Golding picked him up.

The 15-year-old added that Golding stopped at a tavern to purchase beer, then drove to an area near the prison farm where the older man allegedly made advances.

Police were at a stake-out last night at Stop 33, Lake Shore drive, where they said Golding made arrangements to meet the boy.

According to officers, Golding apparently realized police were present after the boy got into his car and sped off.

Detectives pursued the car into New Buffalo, Mich., where it was turned around and came back to Michigan City, being stopped at the city limits at a road block.

Police pointed out that there is a possibility of federal action due to transportation over the state line.
