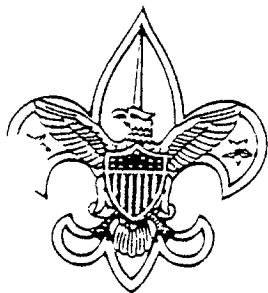

24 ADVICE TO DEFENDANT

25 After you have successfully performed all of the provisions
26 of your probation and within the time that the court retains jur-
27 isdiction (see paragraph 3 above), you may come back into court
28 and ask to withdraw your plea of guilty and enter a plea of not
29 guilty. If the court lets you do this, it will then dismiss
30 this case and you will be released from all penalties and dis-
31 abilities which have resulted from it.

32 The burden of requesting a dismissal of the case is upon
you. The court will not dismiss it unless you ask. You may
request dismissal yourself, or through your attorney or proba-
tion officer.

APPENDIX, CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

- ASW A. LAW: Defendant shall not violate any Federal, State or local criminal law, nor shall defendant be in the company of any person known to him to be doing so.
- ASW B. JAIL: Defendant shall serve 60 days in the Clarke County Jail (with credit for time served), but to be PLE with work release is available on or after 9/16/83 before 6:30, Wednesday, etc.
 - ASW 1. Said jail time may be served on (work-release) (school-release) under a program approved by the proper officers.
 2. Work/Training Release may be applied for after _____ days.
 3. The defendant (may) (may not) be released from the security part of the jail for the purpose of securing: employment, school employment, school enrollment and special counseling with the approval of and under the supervision of jail staff.
 4. Trustee status (is) (is not) authorized.
- ASW C. TREATMENT: Defendant shall attend and successfully complete all inpatient and outpatient phases of the Sexual Offender Treatment program of Sexual Offender Treatment. He shall begin on or before: now.
- ___ D. EDUCATION: Defendant shall attend and successfully complete all phases of the _____ educational program. He shall begin on or before: _____.
- ASW E. EMPLOYMENT: Defendant shall seek, obtain and maintain full time employment, and not change employment without prior permission of the court or his probation officer.
- ASW F. RESIDENCE: Defendant shall live at his present address unless given prior permission to move by the court or his probation officer.
- ASW G. ASSOCIATION: Defendant shall not initiate or permit communication or contact with persons known to the defendant to be convicted felons or presently on probation for any offense, except immediate family. Additionally, defendant shall not initiate or permit communication or contact with: Christine Kelly or any family of Kelly, except as approved in advance by probation officer.
- ___ H. POSSESSION OR USE:
 - ASW 1. Except by lawful medical prescription, defendant shall not possess, use or deliver drugs prohibited by the Uniform Controlled Substances Act.
 - ASW 2. Defendant shall not use alcoholic beverages to excess.
 - ___ 3. Defendant shall not possess or consume any alcoholic beverage.
 - ___ 4. Defendant shall not go into any place where alcoholic beverages are the primary item of sale.
 - ___ 5. Defendant shall submit to a program of monitored antabuse until notified by his probation officer that such program is no longer necessary.
 - ASW 6. Defendant shall submit to urine, breath or other screening to detect usage of drugs or alcohol, as requested by his probation officer.
 - ASW 7. Defendant shall not possess or use any firearm or deadly weapon except for military duty.

I. MONEY:

Defendant shall pay the following to the County Clerk:

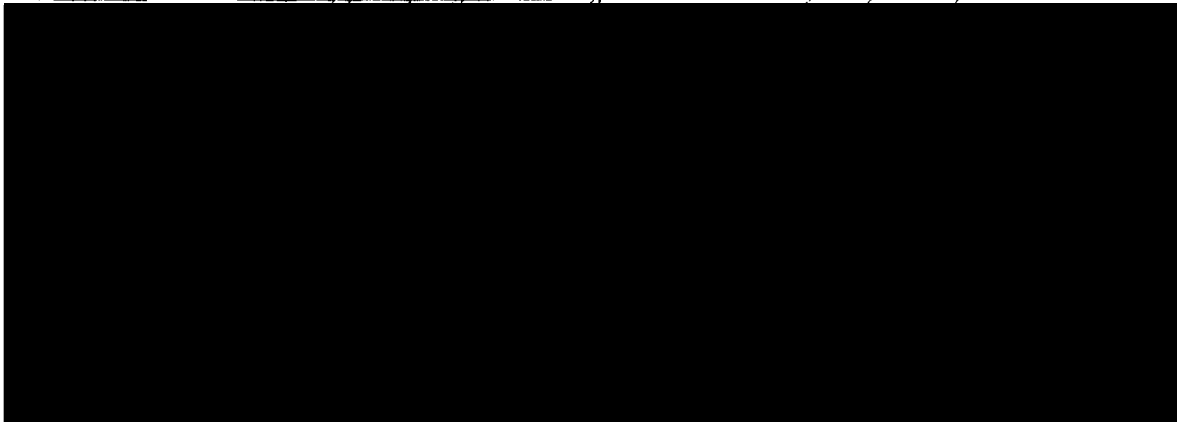
1. Crime Victim Penalty Assessment pursuant to RCW 7.68.035 of \$50.00 to be paid 28 days from today or release from jail.
2. A \$ _____ fine, to be paid in full on or before: _____.

4. 70⁰⁰ court costs, to be paid in full on or before: _____.
5. \$ _____ reimbursement for the cost of court appointed counsel, to be paid in full on or before: _____.
6. The sum of the applicable provisions above shall be paid at not less than \$ 120⁰⁰ per month, commencing: now and to be paid in full on or before: 8/1/83.

(If any of the above subparagraphs are applicable to this defendant but no amount is set out, such amounts shall be set by the probation officer. In the event the probation officer and defendant cannot agree on such amounts, the probation officer will notify the court and a hearing will be scheduled.)

J. PROBATION SUPERVISION: The defendant shall be under the charge and supervision of a probation and parole officer et al, and shall follow the conditions in this order and the rules imposed by that officer. Defendant shall fully and truthfully report to such officer at such times as the officer directs. The defendant shall first report to the officer at or before the close of business on the first business day following today or the defendant's release from jail or inpatient treatment, whichever is later. The deputy prosecutor whose signature appears on this order shall cause a copy of this order to be delivered to the probation office by the close of business today, and the probation office shall immediately notify the court and the prosecutor if the defendant does not appear at the probation office by the close of business on the business day following today.

K. BENCH PROBATION: The defendant shall be on bench probation.
