FORMER SHERIFF'S DEPUTY ENTERS GUILTY PLEA: A former Clayton County deputy sheriff pleaded guilty Friday to one count of simple battery and two counts of exhibiting obscene material to minors, according to Clayton State Court Solicitor Keith Martin.

Rory O'Connor, who had worked four years in court services, will be sentenced within a month, Mr. Martin said.

The battery charge resulted from the spanking of a minor, according to Clayton Deputy Sheriff Stanley Tuggle.

Mr. O'Connor was fired May 8, the same day he was arrested, Deputy Tuggle said.

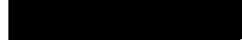

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be denied. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be granted. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS PROVIDED SHOULD YOU DESIRE A REVIEW BY THE SOUTHEAST REGION, BSA, OF THE DECISION TO DENY YOUR REGISTRATION.

1. Within 60 days, you must request in writing a review of this decision. Your request should be sent to Southeast Region, Boy Scouts of America, P. O. Box 440228, Kennesaw, Georgia 30144. In your request you must include your version of what occurred in support of your claim that registration should not have been denied.
2. Upon the receipt of your written request, a committee will be appointed to review the situation.
3. If the regional review committee determines that a review hearing is necessary, the committee will advise you whether or not you may attend. In some instances, no useful purpose would be served by having the applicant present. The hearing is not adversarial in nature and neither the committee nor you, if you attend, will be represented by legal counsel. If you wish, in the event you attend, you may be accompanied by not more than two other individuals if their testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
4. The committee will review the facts as presented, and may interview any persons whose testimony might assist them in arriving at a correct decision.
5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
6. If you are dissatisfied with the decision of a regional review, you may request a further review by the National Council. The decision of the National Council will be final.

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
