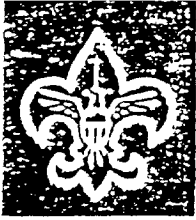
Man convicted of molestation

HYMERA — A man accused of molesting three Jasonville boys in 1989 was convicted of one count of child molesting in Greene County Thursday.

Ray Mondary, 24, of Hymera pleaded guilty to the charge as part of an agreement with the Greene County prosecutor's office. Mondary was arrested on Feb. 13 on three felony charges.

Under the agreement, Mondary, who was a Boy Scout leader and Little League Baseball coach, received an eight-year prison term and must pay a \$100 fine in addition to any counselling the juveniles must undergo as a result of being molested.

Mondary was living in Jasonville at the time of molesting incidents, which involved three boys under the age of 16.

Dear Mr. Roy E. Mondary

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be denied. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. As your registration is in a lapsed status, no refund of your registration fee is due you.

You should understand that the BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explain your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

The following information is provided should you desire a review by the East Central Region, BSA, of the decision to deny your registration.


1. Within 60 days, you must request in writing a review of this decision. Your request should be sent to the regional director, East Central Region, BSA. In your request you may include your version of what occurred in support of your claim that your registration should not have been denied.
2. Upon the receipt of your written request, a committee will be appointed to review the situation.
3. You may attend the review hearing, but it is not adversarial in nature and neither the committee nor you will be represented by legal counsel. If you wish, you may be accompanied by no more than two other individuals if their testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
4. The committee will review the facts as presented and may interview any persons whose testimony might assist them in arriving at a correct decision.
5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
6. If you disagree with the decision of the committee you may request a review of this decision by the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America.

Memorandum of Facts - ROY E. MONDARY

May 11, 1990

The following facts were gathered by Nichol C. Ivey, Finance Director, Hoosier Trails Council in regard to "Ineligible Volunteer File" on Mr. Roy E. Mondary.

1. The "Herald Times" newspaper (Bloomington, Indiana) on Friday, May 4, 1990 ran an article headlined "Man convicted of molestation" which identified the individual as a "Ray Mondary, 24 of Hymeria (Indiana)" this article also stated that Mondary was a Boy Scout leader. (Copy attached)
2. On Monday, May 7, 1990, we identified a Ray E. Mondary, address in Hymera, registered with a lapsed Boy Scout Troop No. S-0457, Jasonville, IN as an Assistant Scout Master.
3. On Tuesday, May 8, 1990, Mr. Michael Konnert, ASM S-057 stated that the individual was in fact Roy Mondary not Ray as identified in the Harold Times. He also stated that to the best of his knowledge the molestation(s) did not have any scouting connection.
4. Roy E. Mondary's registration was immediately deleted.
5. On Thursday, May 10, 1990, Mr. Donald Fish, Scout Master, S-057 and Police Officer in Jasonville, Indiana, provided the following information: He (Fish) was the investigating officer, Mondary was living with the two families at various times and had brought the three boys into both Little League and the Boy Scouts. Mondary had been baby sitting for a period of time for these families and the molestation(s) had occurred in these homes. Fish stated that he had not uncovered any evidence of any abuse in any scouting context. Fish further stated that the youth involved were receiving counseling through their families insurance plans and he did not think that there was any need for assistance from the BSA. He declined to identify the youth or families.
6. As Mr. Roy E. Mondary is incarcerated in the Gibson County Jail, until transfer to the Indiana Penal System, the letter advising him that his registration with the BSA (copy attached) has been sent to him in jail, via certified mail.
