

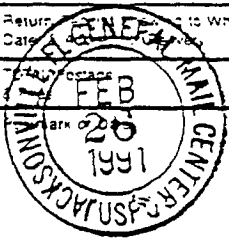

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be granted. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

Attachment to Letter

The following information is provided should you desire a review by the Southeast Region, BSA, of the decision to deny your registration.

1. Within 60 days, you must request in writing a review of this decision. Your request should be sent to: Southeast Region, BSA, PO Box 440728, Kennesaw, Georgia 30144. In your request you must include your version of what occurred in support of your claim that registration should not have been denied.
2. Upon the receipt of your written request, a committee will be appointed to review the situation.
3. If the regional review committee determines that a review hearing is necessary, the committee will advise you whether or not you may attend. In some instances, no useful purpose would be served by having the applicant present. The hearing is not adversarial in nature and neither the committee nor you, if you attend, will be represented by legal counsel. If you wish, in the event you attend, you may be accompanied by no more than two other individuals if their testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
4. The committee will review the facts as presented, and may interview any persons whose testimony might assist them in arriving at a correct decision.
5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
6. If you are dissatisfied with the decision of a regional review, you may request a further review by the National Council. The decision of the National Council will be final.

The Victim STATED THAT WHEN SHE WAS APPROXIMATELY 7 YRS OLD THAT THE SUSPECT [REDACTED] WOULD HAVE HER COME IN AFTER SCHOOL, REMOVE HER CLOTHING AND FORCE HER TO PERFORM ORAL SEX ON HIM. THE SUSPECT WOULD ALSO PERFORM ORAL SEX ON THE VICTIM AND MAKE HER GET ON TOP OF HIM AND "LIE HIM" PLACING HIS PENIS BETWEEN HER LEGS AND FORCING THE VICTIM TO MOVE BACK AND FORTH WHILE SHE WAS ASTRIDE HIM. THE SUSPECT WOULD REMOVE HIS PENIS AND EJACULATE INTO THE TOILET TELLING THE VICTIM "THAT'S HOW YOU MAKE BABIES." ACCORDING TO THE VICTIM THESE INCIDENTS OCCURRED AGAINST DAILY FOR APPROXIMATELY 10 ONE YEAR. Duval violent crime rises 16% in year

Aggravated assault, rape tallies soar

Violent crime in Jacksonville jumped 16 percent last year, with aggravated assault and rape showing the largest gains, police said yesterday.

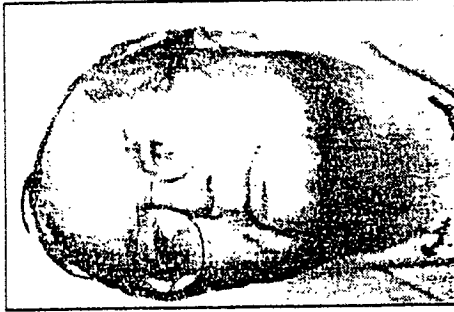
The number of total violent crimes jumped from 10,240 in 1989 to 11,862 last year.

The number of aggravated assaults reported last year was 30 percent higher than 1989, while the number of rapes grew 16.1 percent, according to preliminary statistics released yesterday by the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office.

The increase in rapes occurs one year after Duval County ranked first in the state in the number of forcible sex crimes per 100,000 people. Forcible sex crimes includes rape, forced fondling and forced sodomy.

On the positive side, property crime decreased 4.8 percent and overall crime dropped 1.8 percent.

Appeals court ordered release

Abuse conviction overturned, Duval stepfather is released

A Jacksonville man convicted in 1989 of molesting his young stepdaughter became a free man yesterday — but not until after a judge told him that he hopes the man spends the rest of his life in a "private hell."

Rubin Curtis McGahee, 49, walked out of the Duval County Jail with his father about 12:30 p.m. and told a reporter that he had "no comment" about his future plans after 18 months in prison.

Three hours earlier, in an emotion-charged courtroom, Circuit Judge John D. Southwood complied with orders from the 1st District Court of Appeal to release McGahee. The appellate court had ruled that the 1972 rape law used to prosecute McGahee when his step daughter came forward — 17 years after being molest

ed — doesn't apply to his case.

Southwood paused several times to keep his voice from breaking as he told McGahee that releasing him was one of the most "unpleasant duties" that he has had during his bench tenure.

"Hopefully, you will have to live in your own private hell for the rest of your life," the judge said. "At least at this point in time, the world is aware of these things that Mr. McGahee has done."

The victim's husband and the lead prosecutor in the case left the courtroom weeping. Assistant State Attorney Audrey Moran said she never had seen Southwood as filled with emotion.

"What he heard in his courtroom was horrifying, just

The reasons are many. Chief among them is that our legal system too often is a joke.

You don't have to look beyond what happened Thursday in Circuit Judge John D. Southwood's court for proof of that.

In 1989, Southwood sentenced Rubin Curtis McGahee to 40 years in prison for heinous acts that he had committed 17 years before against his stepdaughter, then 8 years old

For two years, when the little girl came home from elementary school, McGahee would be waiting for her. He would force her to perform oral sex. If she refused, he would beat her naked body with a belt.

Yes, McGahee truly was a swell guy.

When he wasn't abusing his stepdaughter, he would play a neat little game wherein he would "hunt" his stepchildren with a BB gun, telling them to run and

hide — while he shot at them.

The girl lived with this horror for 17 years until she had a nervous breakdown and was hospitalized for depression. She then broke her silence and talked to prosecutors.

McGahee was arrested. He confessed and Southwood ordered him put where he belonged — away.

Then along came game playing lawyers more interested in technicalities than in justice.

No one questioned McGahee's guilt or the despicable nature of his crimes. Instead, his lawyers argued that McGahee was prosecuted wrongly.

He had been convicted of rape, and — his lawyers argued on appeal — the rape law in effect when the offenses occurred did not include oral sex.

More game players — the appellate court judges —

listened and sided with McGahee. He must be released, they said. He shouldn't have been imprisoned at all.

So, after serving only 13 months for committing crimes against a child that have terrorized her — and will terrorize her for the rest of her life — McGahee was set free Thursday.

The unpleasant task of opening the door fell to Southwood, the presiding judge in the case.

Southwood had no choice but to comply. At least he did so with a parting wish: "Hopefully you will have to live in your own private hell for the rest of your life." Southwood told McGahee.

That would be only fair.

The community is going through hell because of what the legal system has become

as the jury found it horrifying," she said. "Judge Southwood was very eloquent and very compassionate, and I know his remarks will be appreciated by the victim and her family. . . . Sometimes, legal technicalities get in the way of justice."

McGahee's stepdaughter, now 27, testified in 1989 that her stepfather forced her to perform oral sex nearly every day when she came home from third grade at Justina Road Elementary School. She said that she told her mother, but that they were advised by a psychologist to keep quiet about the abuse.

She came forward in 1989 after she had a nervous breakdown. The Florida Times-Union does not name victims of sexual abuse.

During the time of the abuse and until his conviction, McGahee maintained a "façade of respectability," said Southwood, who had sentenced McGahee to 40 years in prison before the appellate court overturned the conviction.

The court said oral sex wasn't included in the 1972 law used to convict McGahee, who was a Jacksonville Electric Authority engineer when arrested. The statute of limitations already had expired on other laws that prosecutors might have used.

Although McGahee never denied molesting his stepdaughter, "I have never seen in Mr. McGahee any feeling of remorse," Southwood said.

McGahee's guilt never was an issue in the case, said Robert Link, who represented McGahee on the appeal. He said McGahee has paid for his crime by spending 18 months in prison and losing his job and custody of his son from another marriage.

"The bottom line is that this was an illegal prosecution from start to finish," Link said.

The judge also read a letter that McGahee's son wrote to the Times-Union, saying he was enraged that the courts would free "an admitted pedophile who was convicted by a jury of repeatedly forcing an 8-year-old girl to perform unspeakable acts." After the hearing, Southwood gave McGahee a copy of the letter, which was published on yesterday's Times-Union editorial page.

"What a tragedy to see justice that was such a long time coming be undone by the stroke of a pen," the letter reads. "Images of that kind of abuse to my sister invade my mind even as I sleep."
