

SUBJECT: Update on Sam Donahee

DATE: March 1, 1990

I received a call this morning from Deputy Sheriff Jim Cowell and was advised of the following concerning Mr. Donahee, a.k.a. Mark Whitten:

- Mr. Donahee has been arrested by Federal authorities for probation violation and is currently in jail. He will probably be incarcerated for six months.
- An investigation of sexual molestation has been initiated by the Thurston County Sheriff's Office concerning a complaint against Mr. Donahee by a foreign exchange student who has been living with Mr. Donahee for the last year.

This obviously adds a new dimension to our discussions on February 12th. If I can be of any further assistance or if you would like to schedule another meeting concerning this issue, please let me know.

Attached are the documents on Sam W. Donaghe/Mark Whitten.

When you review the adult application, you will note he lists a "minor violation". However, the Federal Government did not view it as such.

He was put on probation for a period of years, and during this time he was not to associate with children, or children's organizations.

While checking on Sam, we came across the federal probation officer in Tacoma who pointed out a concern regarding Sam's potential involvement with the Boy Scouts of America.

From our findings, and your alertness, an active pedophile (who was a member of the Boy Scouts of America) could change his name and be right back in the program. Sam pointed out the way how the National Boy Scouts of America could be used against itself.

Sam's probation officer was very concerned about the evidence they found that by changing his name (which they were unaware of) he could get new documents and possibly use them in other areas.

If it had not been for your alertness, and immediate telephone calls, someone could have been in potential trouble. For sometime Sam had been upset with us for denying his membership with the Boy Scouts of America, and was telling others of his intent to join Mt. Rainier Council (Tacoma).

Thank you for your time, and keep up the good work.

February 23, 1990

1. Summer of 1989 - received phone call from:
Bob Thornton
Federal Probation Officer - Tacoma
[REDACTED]
Second call: February 23, 1990

Mr. Thornton reported that Sam Donaghe notified him (because of probation requirement) that he was registering with the Boy Scouts of America. Sam was advised not to. (The Federal Judge had stated that during his probation he was not to have any association with any youth or youth organization).

2. August 1989 - During the first part of August, Sam called me (Jim Phillips) and told me that the accusations were false, and not of the magnitude everyone was stating. (letter attached)

3. At this time, the review committee was not available to meet. Sam began to mount a major campaign to get registered.

4. January 1, 1990 - Sam began making statements to other Scouters that the Council was unwilling to hear his case, or allow him to be a member. The new Council President, Dick Platner thought (and maybe still thinks) that I, and the Boy Scouts of America had no right to deny registration. Commissioner staff members (who became friends of this man) were asking questions. (All those who were asking are very quiet today).

5. February 16, 1990 - a letter was sent to Sam, and the review committee was in the process of looking into the matter. (letter attached)

6. February 14 - 23, 1990 - Federal probation officers obtained a search warrant, arrested Sam, and confiscated all his computer equipment and software plus found one or two fire arms.

His probation was revoked, and the Fed's. are planning to keep him in jail. Sam's violation was bringing students from other countries (for a fee - which is legal) to study in the United States. However, some of these students were youth under 18 (violation of his probation).

In the search of his home, the officers found correspondence with the National Boy Scouts of America, which caused them to look further. They were not aware that he had changed his name. The Federal Government also wanted to be assured that the change of name on the special award documents did not constitute current membership in the Boy Scouts of America.

Special note: Sam's problem - tells the world about his problem, and how innocent his is.

Re: Appeal to letter written to Sam Donaghe

Mr. Phillips and Mr. Manning:

I do wish to appeal your letter to me asking me to sever relations with the local scouting program. I have done nothing for which I ought to "defend" or "explain myself" in this area or council.

The "convictions" referred to by my probation officer in Tacoma are non-existent, there were three misdemeanor cases at the state level, (over which the federal government has no jurisdiction); some fifteen years ago, but those have long since been officially and legally cleared from my history. The probation officer admits, privately to me, that there are no convictions on any record of mine with regard to these items.

As a result of a letter and documents provided his superiors and the judge in the case, I am quite sure he is more than aware that he overstepped the situation a bit.

The only conviction I have, for anything, is the one I told you about on the application in the scout office, and there were some very complex, and mitigating circumstances, with regard to that incident.

With regard to the supposed "accusation" against me, that does not exist. I was never charged with anything with regard to any such accusation, never arrested, never tied to anything such as alluded to in the supposed accusation.

You would have to know how that "accusation" came about in order to understand why and how the false statement on a passport application case came about, suffice it to say that the matter came about because I tried to stop and change the lifestyle of ██████████ who was, and is, actively engaged in homosexual relationships.

I was warned, by ██████████, that if I tried to interfere in his lifestyle, check on his friends, etc., that a friend of ██████████, who was, is, a Vietnamese attorney had told ██████████ that he could say certain things about me that would be very hard to defend against...the Vietnamese call this "putting the hat on" a person. The accusation is made, theft, homosexuality, alcoholism, whatever, and the person




Dear Mr. Donaghe:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should not be accepted. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that Boy Scouts of America membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of membership the Boy Scouts of America seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a Boy Scouts of America member should be granted. The procedures for review are attached.

has to endure that reputation etc. This is often done among Vietnamese in their home country.

Shortly after [REDACTED] had issued his warnings to me; several incidents happened, to [REDACTED], and he made the false assumption that [REDACTED] was the cause of his embarrassments, and, in a sort of "get back" mode; he made an accusation.

When the police actually asked him to provide details, sign a statement etc. the boy got on a bus and disappeared. We, [REDACTED] did not know, for over six months, where he was...during that time he called, several times, and explained, [REDACTED] that nothing had happened with regard to me along the lines of his accusation, and that he was sorry for having made it.

He had made the accusation just to get me out of his lifestyle and to have me stop checking on his friends etc.

For an Asian, a homosexual lifestyle is not something freely and openly discussed in the family, and he feared my interference, and the family's knowledge of his activities.

The boy has written, and had notarized in front of my wife and his father, two different recantations of his accusation.

His two older brothers have written legal statements and had them notarized stating their brothers statements to them that nothing of a sexual nature ever transpired between myself and their younger brother.

The boy (the third boy in the family is whom we are discussing here) who made the initial accusation has recanted said accusation, he has apologized to my wife and myself in front of other family members and in private. He has asked to come and live with us in Washington State because no one else in [REDACTED] understands him, or seems to care about him, or is willing to work with him. He has done all that he can to undo the damage he did with his accusation which arose out of a situation in which he became angry. I feel no anger toward him, I and my wife have both told him that we have forgotten and forgiven the incident.

I have all necessary documents to prove that there are no longer any "convictions" on my history; other than the one you know about regarding the passport matter.

That matter came about for one simple reason...when the initial accusation was made by [REDACTED] I knew the "police

mentality" would not allow me any kind of a defense due to my prior supposed record. I knew that no one would look at the legal setting aside of such convictions, and would only attempt to convict me of something I did not do... the thought was that if I visited some friends overseas, the mess would be cleared up in a month or two, once we found the boy and got the truth presented to the authorities.

I did a stupid thing with the passport; and I admit that, but I did not do anything more, and certainly not what I was initially accused of doing.

Yet, at the time, I also knew no one would believe me, that I would have to go through a lot of expense and trauma, especially where my immediate family was concerned, in order to try and clear up the situation. I also knew that if the matter did get cleared up, there would still be a lot of damage done to a lot of people.

On the passport violation, I incurred a fifty dollar court cost fine and some three years of federal probation. This is certainly not a "major" crime, and certainly not one for which I ought to be penalized beyond what the court has stated.

What it comes down to is that I have no convictions, other than the one you know about, there is no accusation, there is no open case, there is nothing except what is floating about in the imagination of the probation officer, who did not do the background check on me, who has not been privy to the circumstances of the case etc., etc. and who had no right to make some of the statements he did make to you, since some of those statements had no basis in fact.

Certain documents are open to your inspection if you should so desire. You may speak to the federal probation officer in San Jose, CA. who did do the background check and is fully familiar with this case etc. I would request you hold no further discussion with Mr. Thornton in Tacoma, since this is rather a sore spot with him at the moment. I have spoken to his superiors at length; and as a result; he and I are not on the best of terms at the moment.

As for scouting, it is the only thing, outside my immediate family, which means anything to me. I have stayed out of the program for over fifteen years simply to keep any suggestion by anyone of any wrong activity from arising. When I came here, and I was asked to join, by several scouters in the area, I felt there was no harm, and no problem.

Unfortunately, my probation officer here is somewhat different than the one I had in San Jose, and he views things somewhat differently, and apparently tends to put his own interpretation on certain matters.

He has stated that even if I went in front of the review board, and the board found that I could continue with Scouting in the council, he would stop it. I have no choice, I can not, for the moment, continue, or he will make trouble for me.

I must attempt to clear this matter up with the council, and you, or there will be a "cloud" sort of hanging there and no chance for me to participate later in life when he is no longer in somewhat of a control position in my life.

So, what I am asking is for you to review what I have written and know that I am considerably "straighter" than a lot of people, that I have paid for those mistakes made in my life, not once, but many times over, that I am an "aware" and responsible individual who wishes to serve the Scouting program at some time in the future. But, that I can not now do so, even if your board decides to allow me to participate.

I have paid whatever debt was required by society to expiate anything I have done, I have taken the legal steps to clear whatever matters may have been involved some years ago, and legally these matters are as if they never happened. I have nothing for which to be ashamed or guilty.

I would not, under any circumstances, dishonor Scouting.

I write this letter at the urging of several scouters who believe, as I do, that Scouting teaches a number of worthwhile precepts, and that Scouting does not run on rumor, innuendo, false statements or "accusations" which are unproven, and that I must do something to fight such items.

I still believe, and live, as much as I can, those things I was taught as a boy and a Scout.

If nothing else, I wanted the thought that I was acceptable to the program, even if I were not terribly active in it.

If I can answer any questions, I would be happy to do so in private conversation, and I would provide documents if necessary to prove my statements.

I would request that the door be left open to me to serve at sometime in the future. Neither you, nor Scouting, have anything to fear from me, my only desire is understanding of my position, which is that I have done no wrong that impacts on this council or Scouting, and that I do have the right, once off probation, to serve, honorably, a program I love.

On February 23 at 1:30 I talked to Jim Phillips, Scout Executive council no. 737, related to the above named individual. This individual had been involved with the Boy Scouts of America and had recently changed his name from Sam Donaghe. He wrote to the Eagle Scout Service and had a new Eagle Certificate prepared under his new name. He did furnish official documents for the change of name.

Mr. Whitten has now been picked up by the authorities because he violated his probation which was related to false information charge on his passport. He has been held in custody at the present time for this violation of probation, which indicated he could not have any activities with youth. Apparently, he did not adhere to that through his registration with the Boy Scouts of America and some other operations with which he was involved.

Mr. Phillips will be sending us more information on this matter.
