Probation, Fine in Sex Case

ronner burbank-Glendale-Fasadena Airport executive Samuel L. Jones has been sentenced to five years probation and fined \$1,000 by a Pasadena Superior Court judge for sexual misconduct involving three teen-age boys.

Other conditions of the sentence imposed last week by Judge Gilbert Alston prohibit Jones, 40, from associating with minors unless another adult is present, and require that he receive psychiatric or psychological counseling, according to Deputy Dist. Atty. Rebecca Omens.

If Jones violates the conditions of his probation, Omens added, he could face up to eight years in prison.

Jones, who met one of the boys while he was a volunteer with Big Brothers of America, pleaded guilty in March to one felony count of committing lewd and lascivious acts with a minor and two misdemeanor counts of contributing to the delinquency of a minor. Alston dismissed three other counts of child molestation, child annoying and contributing to the delinquency of a minor, Omen said.

The incidents occurred in August, 1983, and last January at Jones' South Pasadena home, Omens said. Two boys were 13 and one was 15 at the time, she said.

Jones was arrested in January at his office by investigators from the Los Angeles Police Department's sexually exploited child unit. Big Brother representatives had contacted the police after receiving a complaint from the mother of Jones' former "little brother" that Jones had molested according to Detective Dale Barraclough.

Jones resigned from his position as manager of community relations for the airport on Jan. 27, a week after he was arrested. He had served in that job four years.

As you may know, the Council Executives of Southern California Scouting had a special meeting on July 3, 1978. At this meeting they voted to suspend the agreement with Fund Raisers, Inc. as it relates to the development campaign.
