It was brought to our attention by [REDACTED] that Mr. Windedahl, while a juvenile, was put on probation for child abuse in August 1990. Mr. Windedahl is not currently registered with the Boy Scouts of America. His last affiliation was with Post 52 in Milliken, Colorado.

Mr. Charlie Jones,

I'm writing this letter to you by request of [redacted] concerning Scott of Spindedah.

My son was sexually molested by him in broad daylight in a Grocery store that he was employed by. He is extremely polite and appears to be a nice young man and therefore quite a surprise to us. He takes an active interest in young children and because he is so nice, it seems OK.

We have gone to court and he was convicted of Child Molestation. However, he was a minor at the time, so this is a juvenile case.

He is on probation with an undetermined termination date. He is not to be with young people without supervision. He is to attend counselling. These are the terms set by the judge in court.

Probation officer in charge is a Mrs (Miss) Sarah Leish at [redacted] Or call [redacted] at [redacted]

There are other cases in Mulliken, Johnstown, Greeley and St Collins of which I am aware none of these have gone to court.

In the meantime, Scott continues to put himself in contact with young people. Namely, attendance, at Scout Show, unaccompanied and working at Harrow Skating Rink. He has recently left Harrow by order of the probation officer after working there ~ 9 months.

He was convicted August 1990 and
apparently went right to work at Haroco.
