

Scout master is accused of sex with troop members

A Wheat Ridge Cub Scout master has been charged with sexually assaulting youths in his troop.

Stephen D. Freeman, 34, of was arrested by Wheat Ridge police May 14 after two brothers told their parents they had sexual contact with Freeman.

Four charges of sexual assault on a child have been filed against Freeman, but police said they believe as many as 18 other youngsters may have been sexually assaulted by the construction worker.

The alleged assaults came to light after Freeman hosted an overnight Cub Scout jamboree and barbecue at his apartment complex. The mother of two boys, 9 and 11, became worried about the youngsters-spending the night at Freeman's apartment because of previous comments they had made about the pack leader.

She picked up the boys before the end of the evening and they confided Freeman had been abusing them sexually since February, the police report indicates.

The boys told police Freeman would get a handful of youths to play strip poker at his apartment. The player drawing the high card would tell the holder of the low card what sexual acts to perform. They also said he had coffered them money for sexual favors.

Two of the charges against Freeman involve 8-year-old and 7-year-old The boy told police he began having sexual contact with when he entered the third grade. The children have been placed in a

Police still are investigating the case. The other youngsters police believe had sexual contact with Freeman were in the Scout troop or lived near his apartment.

Freeman was taken into custody May 14 and bond was set at \$25,000.

Man pleads guilty to child sex counts

Stephen Freeman, a 34-year-old former Cub Scout leader in Wheat Ridge, pleaded guilty Thursday to four charges of sexual assault on children.

The victims were identified 9year-old 7-year-old and two seems ages 11 and 9 who lived nearby.

Freeman, of entered his plea in Golden District Court. He told investigators he'd had sex with at least 31 children — most of whom were boys who lived in the Briarwood apartment complex or were members of his scout pack.

Prosecutors agreed not to file 20 additional counts against the unemployed roofer in exchange for his guilty plea to the four charges, according to Robert Ruddy, deputy district attorney.

Freeman was fired from his volunteer job as scout leader as soon as the allegations against him came to light last May. He faces up to 10 years in prison on each charge. He is being held in Jefferson County Jail on \$25,000 bond.

Statements from many of his victims indicate Freeman either forced or enticed them into having sex with him, investigators said. There are no indica-

tions he was violent toward any of his victims.

Once arrested, Freeman cooperated with authorities by providing a list of the children he'd molested. The children, some of whom had sex with Freeman numerous times, ranged in age from 6 to 11, according to Ruddy.

Freeman allegedly offered money and alcoholic beverages to his victims in order to entice them to perform sex acts in front of him and each other.

He was arrested last May after the two young brothers, who'd been invited to spend the night at his house and attend a scouting function the next day; told their parents he'd had sex with them.

The boys told police Freeman had engaged in sexual acts with them several times since February.

They also told police Freeman would gather a group of neighborhood childern at his home to play strip poker, and the winners would dictate to the losers what sex acts they had to perform in front of the group.

They further said their told them they'd go to jail if they told anyone about what he did to them.

Sentencing has been set for Nov. 19.
