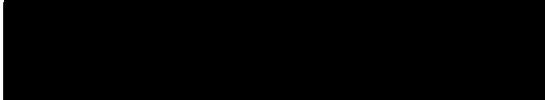

We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of membership the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be granted or reinstated. The procedures for review are attached.

SUNDAY, JULY 9

P.M.

20 year old Steve Horrall, ASM, Troop 203, Vincennes, Indiana, asked Jerry Polk, SM, Troop 245, if it would be alright if he slept in a tent with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], all 11 year old Scouts in Troop 245 (245 and 203 came to camp together and were set up on the same site). Polk advised against it and Horrall tented with [REDACTED] ASM, Troop 203.

THURSDAY, JULY 13

P.M.

Horrall told Polk he wanted to sleep in the tent with the 3 boys on Thursday night. Polk had "never seen anything out of the way" and "saw no problem". Horrall tented with the boys Thursday night.

FRIDAY, JULY 14

@ 3:00 A.M. [REDACTED] woke [REDACTED] and told him that Horrall had "snuggled" up to [REDACTED] and placed his hand on [REDACTED] bottom. [REDACTED] said he rolled away and that Horrall moved closer and placed a hand on [REDACTED] genitals. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] he pushed Horrall's hand away and left the tent.

[REDACTED] told [REDACTED] to get his gear and move into a tent with himself and ASM Mike Buchannon. [REDACTED] then confronted Horrall outside the boys' tent and asked "What's going on". Horrall replied that he had been "jacking off" and that if he touched [REDACTED] "it was by accident". Polk talked to Horrall about the inappropriateness of this action, and then allowed him to return to the boys' tent. Polk then notified Bill Marsh of the situation.

Around 12:00 noon on Friday, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] approached Jerry Polk and indicated that after [REDACTED] had left the tent, Horrall asked [REDACTED] if he knew what a "hard-on" was, and then explained what it was. Polk immediately related this story to Bill Marsh, SM, Troop 203.

Horrall spent Friday night in a tent with [REDACTED], ASM, Troop 203.

At 7:40 a.m., Jack Bailey, CC for Troop 203 brought this story to Frank Madison, district executive, who took Bailey directly to Steve Wilburn, Camp Director. Wilburn notified Bruce Tuten, Scout Executive, and was instructed to conduct interviews with each of the parties involved.

The following information was taken from these interviews.

After interviewing all parties involved, the Marshall County Department for Social Services was contacted and notified of this incident.

STEVE MORRALL - [REDACTED] Wheatland, IN 47597 [REDACTED]
Registered with Troop 200 or 203, ASM 203, 20 years old. Basic leader training included Youth Protection Training with video.

SUNDAY, JULY 8

3 boys - [REDACTED], Troop 245 - asked Steve to stay in their tent on Sunday night (Steve knew [REDACTED] from working with his mother on district Cub Day Camp staff). On Thursday Steve spent the night in the boys' tent..... "been away from girlfriend for about 2 weeks. Thought everyone was asleep and was jacking off. I guess they woke up and caught me". (Did not spend night in boys' tent until Thursday because "wanted to get my gear sorted and figured the boys needed a night or two to get set up and get gear straight.") [REDACTED] got up to use the bathroom and later came back and got sleeping gear and left tent. Shortly afterward, Jerry Polk, SM, Troop 245, asked Steve to come out of the tent and talked about the above incident. Jerry asked him what happened, and Steve related the story as written above. Re: touching incident "sometimes when I sleep I toss and turn". Jerry asked if Steve could be trusted to go back in the tent and go to sleep, which he did until around 6:30 a.m. on Friday.

[REDACTED] 11 year old Scout

[REDACTED], who had met Steve at day camp, wanted to know if Steve could spend the night on Sunday - [REDACTED] said "no - maybe some other night".

Steve wanted to spend the night on Thursday and did. [REDACTED] was awake, Steve moved closer to [REDACTED] and touched his bottom, [REDACTED] moved and told him to stop. Shortly afterward, about 5 minutes, Steve scooted close

to [REDACTED] and placed his hand on [REDACTED] upper thigh and started moving his hand near [REDACTED]'s "private area." [REDACTED] removed his hand and left the tent. He spent the rest of the night with Jerry Polk and Mike Buchannon, SM & ASM of Troop 245. [REDACTED] was asleep and [REDACTED] was awake.

[REDACTED] talked to [REDACTED] after this incident on Friday.

Steve was sleeping on the floor between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] left the tent and woke [REDACTED] up. [REDACTED] asked where he was going. Steve said "to the bathroom" [REDACTED] heard Steve's sleeping bag "shaking" [REDACTED] asked what Steve was doing. Steve responded that he was masterbating and explained what it was and that "you only do it when you have a 'hard on'", then explained what a "hard-on" was. Steve said "it felt good" and that [REDACTED] should try it.
