man pleads guilty to sex abuse

An Anniston area electrician pleaded guilty Tuesday to sexually abusing a female relative, now 13. The plea came just before opening statements were to begin in his trial in Circuit Court. Steven Quattlebaum, 46, of Anniston, Rt. 6, pleaded guilty on Tuesday morning following the selection of a jury on Monday.

Quattlebaum pleaded guilty to sexual abuse and was sentenced to 20 years in the county jail.

Quattlebaum had originally faced charges which included first-degree rape, first-degree sodomy and second-degree sodomy, and sexual abuse.

Quattlebaum scheduled an Oct. 17 hearing on Payne's request for probation. He was indicted by the January grand jury in connection with allegations that he had sexually abused the victim over a six-year period.

The prosecutor, Assistant District Attorney Carolyn Morgan, said the plea bargain was useful in avoiding a conviction and sparing the victim the need to testify.

MEMORANDUM

Meeting was held with Mr. Payne on the above date in regard to charges filed against him for alleged sexual child abuse of his daughter. Mr. Payne has been formally charged by authorities with separate counts of [REDACTED] rape, sexual abuse and sodomy. He has been indicted by the grand jury with trial date set for mid-May.

Mr. Payne was presented with a letter signed by the Council president informing him that his registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. [Letter used was taken from Appendix C, Page 16, of the Boy Scout booklet on "Sexual Child Abuse."] Mr. Payne was also presented a copy of the procedure required for requesting a council review of his registration. (Appendix D, Page 17, of the Boy Scout booklet "Sexual Child Abuse.")

Mr. Payne's reply to the letter was to express innocence of the charges filed against him, stating that [REDACTED] had made up the accusations because [REDACTED]. Our response was to assure Mr. Payne that our role was not to determine guilt or innocence but rather to follow the prescribed guidelines of the Boy Scouts of America in regard to such charges.



Mr. Payne agreed to remove himself from Scouting in both Pack 48 and Troop 248, where he is registered as a member of the troop committee.

As a result of the written allegations enclosed, the Choccolocco Council requests that Mr. Payne be placed in the CONFIDENTIAL FILE. (Confidential record sheet is enclosed.)
