
However, we can give you the following information for your files; Stewart Clayborne, colored-male, dob 10-28-34, with the following alias's; Stewart Claydorne, Stewart Ross Claydorne, Ertha Wilson, Ertha Allison, Mary Clayborne, James Reed and Ertha Williams, and has been arrested numerous times for Petit Larceny, Shoplifting, Prostitution and Occupying Rooms for Prostitution. SUBJECT IS A KNOWN FEMALE IMPERSONATOR, with CPD #95125.

Subject was last arrested on 12-26-74, for the crime he has been bound over for, which involved a nine (9) year old cubscout, the case now pending in court.

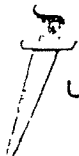

Apparently some of the initial information that was sent did not reach you. Therefore, I am enclosing the material in hope that this will complete the information needed to place Clayborne on the confidential file.

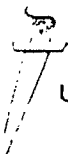

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
