Dear Mr. Wheatcroft:

This letter is being written on the advice of my attorney in response to yours of September 25, 1987.

I must say I was surprised and dismayed to receive it. Your action is, at the least, high-handed, arbitrary, and groundless. You might have had the common decency and courtesy to discuss the rationale for your decision with me. Since you did not disclose the basis for concluding me unfit to continue as a leader in Scouting I can only surmise it is your hysterical reaction to an allegation made about me. I am, of course, aware of this allegation. You must know, and I certainly want the record to show, that I deny the veracity of the allegation categorically and unequivocally.

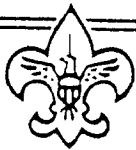
However, I also want you to know something else. Several months ago I concluded, for reasons totally unrelated to this ridiculous and unfounded allegation, that I no longer desired to participate in Scouting as it has become in this Council. For your information, I resigned from the Properties Committee in June. That was but the first step in the process of ceasing my Scouting activities. I intend to continue, of my own volition, and in an orderly fashion, the process of severing the remaining the remaining ties I have with Scouting. But know this, and know it well, if I desired to continue to participate in this program I would pursue whatever means might be at my disposal to retain my registration.

I demand that this slanderous and defamatory matter be expunged from my record and that the record show I voluntarily terminated my Scouting registration. I expect you to confirm to me in writing that this has been done. If I have not heard from you to this effect within ten days from the date of this letter I will instruct my attorney to take appropriate action.

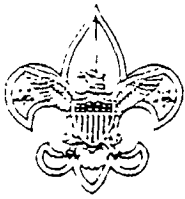

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should not be accepted. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be granted.

Mill-o-Say, and an extension of Leadership + Growth.

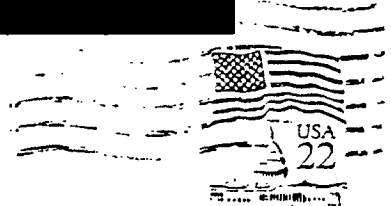
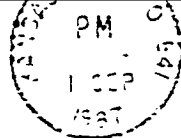
