



MEMORANDUM ON CONVERSATION WITH THERON A. JONES NOVEMBER 16, 1989 4:45 P.M. AT THE SCOUT SERVICE CENTER

Mr. Theron A. Jones, a Scouting volunteer registered as an Assistant Scout-master of Troop 124, chartered to Newman United Methodist Church, was asked to attend a meeting with the Scout Executive, Terry Lawson. Mr. Jones lives at Alexandria, Louisiana, 71301 and is employed as a salesman at Caplan's in the Mall, a men's wear store.

The meeting was conducted in the Scout Executive's office with Theron A. Jones, Terry C. Lawson, and Rev. R. Chip Turner (council vice-president for Membership/Relationships) present.

Mr. Lawson presented to Theron Jones a letter stating that he must remove himself from participation and association with the Boy Scouts of America. Terry stated that an allegation had been made about Theron Jones concerning homosexuality and that because of the procedures of the Boy Scouts of America in this regard, Theron must not associate with Scouting while an investigation is being conducted. Reference was made to Theron that we were not accusing him, nor was he on trial, but that due to our high standards of leadership, while the matter is being investigated, he must not associate with Scouting. Theron indicated he understood the reasoning why.

Terry Lawson also told Theron the procedure he needs to follow, if he wishes to appeal this action. An information sheet with the procedures was given to him. Theron was also given a refund check of \$7.00 to return his registration fee.

Theron asked if he would have an opportunity to face his accusers. Terry stated that, while he understood his desire to do so, that we would not make the names of the individual (s) available to him. It is more important for Theron to work and clear his name than confront the persons making the accusation.

Theren stated that this was a shock to him and that Scouting was his life. Rev. Turner and I told Theron that we wanted to be compassionate with him, that we were not accusing him, and that we hoped it was not true and he could clear the accusation. Mr. Lawson did state to Theron that the burden of disproving the accusation was on Theron. While that may not seem fair, we have to protect the youth involved in Scouting and maintain our high standards of leadership. We also told Theron that, with the exception of the Council President, we would not inform other members of the Scouting community of this action or the reasons why.

The meeting was concluded at approximately 5:12 P.M.

The following is additional information related to the case of the suspended membership of Theron Jones, that I became aware of this past week during a telephone conversation with USAF Office of Special Investigations Agent Jim Mullihan last week.

First, Theron Jones introduced the Scout victim to the USAF person who is a known homosexual. It was during this same evening that the USAF person seduced the Scout victim.

Second, Theron Jones has at least two known homosexuals as close friends.

Third, Theron Jones is actively in contact with known homosexuals through work stating that most of his customers are homosexuals.

Fourth, Theron Jones has at least two friends who are under investigation by the Air Force for homosexual activities involving Boy Scouts from Troop 25 of the Attakapas Council.

Fifth, Theron Jones frequents homosexual bars to listen to the music there.

Sixth, Theron Jones refused to be interviewed a second time by USAF Special Agent Jim Mullihan.

In conclusion, let it be known that I have never met Theron Jones nor do I hold malice toward him. It is in my capacity as Socut Executive that I forward this information to you knowing that his membership in the Boy Socuts of America has been suspended and that he has appealed that decision.

It is my understanding that Theron Jones has requested reveiw of his suspension from Scouting. For many years I have known and admired Theron's enthusiasm, talents, and potential, both in and out of Scouting. The revelation of his alleged problem was a deep personal shock. It is therefore with extreme regret that I must convey the following.

Information has been brought to my attention that Theron has been questioned in an investigation involving other individuals under charges for related activities. Theron has clearly misrepresented and misconstructed his knowledge of certain events during this questioning. I must recommend against his reinstatement.

It is reassuring that this investigation, on its own initiative, also considered the extent and effects of this activity within this Council. It has concluded that we do not have a problem. Public disclosure is not anticipated.

My source of information cannot be revealed, but it is totally reliable, first-hand, and impartial. Further details could jeopardize legal proceedings.

The following information is provided should you desire a review by the South Central Region, Boy Scouts of America, of the decision to deny your registration.

- 1. Within 60 days, you must request in writing a review of this decision. Your request should be sent to the Regional Director, South Central Region, BSA (1401 Walnut Hill Iane, P.O. Box 152325, Irving, TX. (75015-2325). In your request you may include your version of what occurred in support of your claim that your registration should not have been denied.
- 2. Upon the receipt of your written request, a committee will be appointed to review the situation.
- 3. You may attend the review hearing, but it is not adversarial in nature and neither the committee nor you will be represented by legal counsel. If you wish, you may be accompanied by no more than two other individuals if their testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
- 4. The committee will review the fact as presented, and may interview any persons whose testimony might assist them in arriving at a correct decision.

- 5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
- 6. If you disagree with the decision of the committee, you may request a review of this decision by the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America.
