THOMAS A DEROSA

On September 20 at 12:00 p.m., I talked to Loren Swenson, Scout Executive, of Pikes Peak Council No. 60 concerning this individual.

Mr. Swenson indicated that Thomas DeRosa had been suspended from registration in the council at the time of the original letter to us dated April 19, 1989. He had continuously tried to get information from the police department both personally and through his District Executive assigned to that district.

The police have not been willing to release any information and nothing has ever appeared in any newspapers. It seems that Mr. DeRosa after his suspension from the police department filed suit against them and this is still pending. This is the reason no information is being released to the public.

Mr. Swenson indicated that he will continue to follow up on this periodically and to try and get us information which will be helpful in the future. He does not have Mr. DeRosa registered, would not register him, and feels that we should have a file to stop him from registering in other locations.

This police department had also changed leaders often and no one knows Mr. DeRosa in order to be able to complete a form which would adequately describe him for our research.

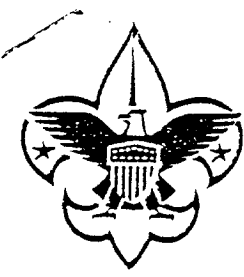
