Strickland pleads guilty to sexual contact charge

A presentence investigation was ordered for a former Beatrice policeman who pleaded guilty Tuesday afternoon to a reduced charge of sexual contact with a 14-year-old child last October.

Tom Strickland, 36, was charged with the Class IV felony during a 45-minute arraignment in Gage County District Court. Maximum penalty is five years imprisonment and a \$10,000 fine.

Strickland, now of Lincoln, was originally charged with sexually assaulting a 14-year-old child, a Class II felony punishable by up to 50 years imprisonment. A jury trial had been scheduled for Tuesday afternoon.

Strickland bent his head in his arms and sobbed as special prosecuting attorney Paul Schelstraete of Crete read evidence for the reduced charge before Judge William Rist.

Schelstraete said the alleged victim told law enforcement officials she was trying on a bathing suit in her room at her

home on the afternoon of Oct. 12 when the sexual contact occurred. It didn't appear that the defendant had sexual intercourse with the girl, Schelstraete said.

Strickland then apparently went to the bathroom and took some pills, Schelstraete said. Strickland allegedly later told a psychiatrist that similar incidents had happened before, "but not to this degree," according to the evidence Schelstraete presented.

Strickland was reportedly hospitalized following the incident.

Strickland's court-appointed attorney Ronald Sutter of Beatrice said the defense didn't agree with all of the testimony, but didn't offer any counter testimony.

As part of a presentence investigation, Rist ordered Strickland to see a Lincoln and an Omaha psychiatrist to determine if he is a mentally disoriented sex offender. Strickland is out of jail on bond.

Strickland had been an officer with the Beatrice Police Department for eight years.

Ex-Beatrice officer pleads innocent

BEATRICE (AP) — Thomas J. Strickland, 36, a former police officer charged with first-degree sexual assault, pleaded innocent in Gage County District Court.

A March 31 jury trial was scheduled Monday for Strickland, who now lives in Lincoln.

The crime allegedly occurred last October and involved a child less than 16 years old.

Jury trial set after innocent plea

A March 31 jury trial has been set for a former Beatrice police officer charged with first degree sexual offense.

Thomas J. Strickland, 36, who now lives in Lincoln, pleaded innocent to the charge in Gage

County District Court Monday.

The offense is a Class II felony, punishable by one to 50 years in prison.

The charges stem from an Oct. 12 incident involving a child less than 16 years of age.

Charge filed

A felony sexual assault charge was filed against Beatrice Police Officer Tom Strickland Friday.

The first degree charge was filed in Gage County Court.

Special prosecutor Paul Schelstraete said Strickland, 36, is under the supervision of the Gage County Mental Health Board. He declined to say where Strickland was staying or release other details of the assault.

Schelstraete is a Crete attorney appointed by Gage County Court Judge Steve Timm to prosecute the case. Beatrice attorney Ron Sutter was appointed Friday to represent Strickland and a further hearing was scheduled for Nov. 7.

Strickland, an eight-year veteran of the Beatrice Police Department, was admitted to a Lincoln hospital two weeks ago following an overdose. Schelstraete would give no details on the abuse incident.

Beatrice Police Chief Don Luckeroth said Friday that Strickland remained on sick leave from the department.

First degree sexual assault is a Class II felony punishable by one to 50 years in prison.
