Dear Paul:

Paul, I was asked to follow-up on Thomas M. Tannehill, by Gus Bosio. Tom was a Scoutmaster in the district, I served.

The Morgan County Prosecutors Office provided me with the following information.

Thomas M. Tannehill pleaded guilty to multiple counts of child molesting and was convicted on October 5, 1990. The original sentence was four years. Three years suspended sentence, one year rehabilitation at the McCormick Center and eight years probation. On May 3, 1991, Tom was brought to court for violation of his probation. On May 31, 1991, Tom was sentenced to serve two years with the Department of Corrections, probation for eight years and Sexual Abuse Counseling through the Department of Corrections.

Tom is now serving the two year prison sentence. I do not know any stipulations concerning Tom's conviction ie., not being able to work with you.

I hope this will complete your file.


Dear Paul

Deaf School employee charged with molestation

A house parent at the Indiana School for the Deaf was arrested Thursday on charges that he molested two students there.

Indiana State Police Sgt. Byron Westmoreland said Thomas M. Tannehill, 37, of the 5300 block of East Washington Street is accused of fondling two deaf boys, ages 12 and 13. Tannehill was being held late Thursday without bond in the county lockup.

School Superintendent Lee Murphy said Tannehill allegedly fondled one of the boys during an overnight trip last year.

However, Westmoreland, a public information officer, said he believed the incidents occurred off-campus in May.

The investigation began when a former student of a school for the deaf in Wisconsin told authorities that Tannehill

had molested two students there, who previously worked at the school.

The student was visiting the Indiana School for the Deaf and discovered Tannehill worked there, Westmoreland said. Police began to interview students at the Indiana School for the Deaf, on two charges of child molesting.

As a house parent, Tannehill acted as a substitute parent for 12 to 15 boys, making, sure they did their homework and other chores. He has been employed at the school for 2½ years, Westmoreland said.

Murphy said the school closed last week for the summer. Tannehill's future employment there depends on the result of the investigation.

Westmoreland said Tannehill had been investigated in Wisconsin in the early 1970s for child molestation but was never charged.

Deaf School house parent faces 2 molest charges

An allegation by a former student led to the arrest Thursday of Thomas M. Tannehill, a house parent at the Indiana School for the Deaf, on two charges of child molesting.

The 37-year-old Tannehill was held to the City-County Lockup in lieu of \$8,500 bond after allegedly admitting he fondled a 12-year-old boy and a 13-year-old boy.

Indiana State Police Sgt. Bernadette Stamper said deaf school students were questioned after one of Tannehill's former students said Tannehill had molested him at a school in Wisconsin in 1973.

The 28-year-old former student was visiting his wife, also a house parent at the Indianapolis school, in February when he recognized Tannehill, 5300 block of East Washington Street. "suspi-

rious" incidents in the last six months involving students under Tannehill's supervision were investigated.

Dr. Lee Murphy, deaf school superintendent, said the Marion County Child Protection Agency and state police were told of the allegations. Tannehill also was informed of the allegations and was told his actions would be monitored.

"He was cautioned never to be alone with students," Murphy said.

Tannehill has worked at the school since December 1987.

Murphy said a police check of Tannehill, made before he was hired, showed no criminal record.

Deaf school students left for summer vacation June 1. School officials said Tannehill is not paid during the summer months and his job status will be determined by the outcome of the case.
