No legal action has been taken to date and the case remains open.



Pleace send us anything you have that would help to complete our file.



In December 1989

He was placed into the first year Webelos den lead by Thomas Palmer. Because he joined well after our September School Night, Mr. Palmer invited to his home after school to work on Bobcat requirements. Mr. Palmer would conduct these afternoon sessions in his bedroom, and would tell that he could sit or lay down on the bed.

OCT 16 1990

On one occasion while Mr. Palmer was bouring beverage in the kitchen, his hand went to groin area. punched Mr. Palmer, said not to do that and left Mr. Palmer's home. Mr. Palmer was confronted by mother and he did not deny the incident.

Dear Mr. Palmer:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of membership the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please inform us in writing within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for review are attached.
