Dear T. J. :

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a council review committee, please write to me within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

PROCEDURE FOR REQUESTING REVIEW  
OF DECISION DENYING REGISTRATION

1. If registration is refused, the applicant may request a review of this decision. This request must be in the form of a written request from the individual which includes his or her version of the facts supporting the claim that registration should not have been denied.
2. Upon receipt of the written request for review, the president of the local council shall appoint a committee to review the situation.
3. The appointed committee should review the facts as presented, and, in addition, may interview any persons whose testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
4. A confidential report will be given to the applicant setting forth the decision of the committee.
5. The applicant may - if he or she does not agree with the decision - request a review from the regional director.
6. If the regional review does not satisfy the applicant, he or she may ask for further review by the National Council. The decision by the National Council is final.

Gentlemen:

This letter is to inform you of my request to become a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America as an Assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 605 Denison, Texas sponsored by the Waples United Methodist Church. After careful consideration I feel that I must appeal this attempt to remove me from the Scouting movement.

I have been a dedicated and faithful scout and scouter for most of my life and am very hurt by the implications that are being spread. I have never done anything immoral or illegal and am very interested to hear the charges that have been brought against me.

I do realize that I have waited longer than the sixty days that was stated on the letter. However, during that time I was very confused and shocked.

Against the advice of my counsel, I am putting my faith in this obviously unconstitutional method that has been set up by the movement. The idea of "guilty before proven innocent" does not and can not exist in our society of democracy.

Upon receipt of your letter requesting a Council Review our committee on Registration met.

Your file was reviewed and the principals were contacted. You were informed on June 24th both orally and in writing that you had a right to a Council Review within 60 days. It is the decision of our committee that more than enough time was given to you for an appeal, and that our original decision will stand.

In many courts across the nation it has been upheld that BSA membership registration is a privilege, and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American Youth. (A negative determination should not be construed as a finding that you are not a decent citizen).

You will not be allowed to register, in any position, with the Boy Scouts of America, and we request that you sever any relations that you may have with any group registered with the BSA.

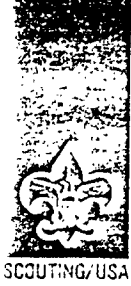
