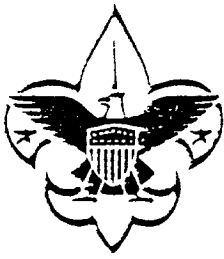

# Former Scout leader sued for \$100,000 after fondling

A lawsuit seeking \$100,000 in damages was filed recently in Circuit Court against a former Smyrna Boy Scout leader convicted of fondling a boy in his troop.

The mother of the 11-year-old abused youth sued Victor Ken Rinehart, 35, of 122 Bailey Collins Drive in Smyrna.

In his January, best-interest plea, Rinehart claimed no memory of the sexual assault but agreed there was sufficient evidence for a plea of guilty, said Bill Whitesell, assistant district attorney.

Circuit Judge James Clayton sentenced the former Boy Scout leader to three years at the Rutherford County Workhouse. He began serving his sentence in March.

Asa Davis, assistant workhouse supervisor, said Rinehart was released Sept. 24 on a court order.

Rinehart's mother said Friday her son was at work but did not want to comment on the lawsuit.

In the lawsuit, the fondled boy's mother stated her son was at Rinehart's home Sept. 30, 1989.

Rinehart approached her son with his pants unzipped and unbuttoned, the lawsuit stated.

The former leader sat on the boy's legs, tried to lay down atop him and grabbed him, the lawsuit alleged.

Rinehart threatened to kill her son if he told anyone of the assault, the lawsuit stated.

The former leader abused a position of trust in his role, the lawsuit stated.

As a result of the abuse, the youth "suffered great pain and anguish of body and mind and was put to great expense for medical and psychological treatment."

Besides the \$100,000, the mother seeks additional punitive damages. She requested a jury trial.

Rinehart worked as a Boy Scout leader 17 years before resigning in October 1989 after his arrest on aggravated sexual battery charges.

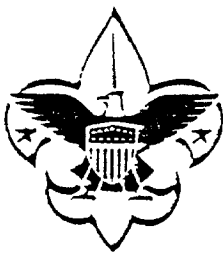

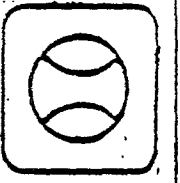

## Sheriff officers probe abuse of Scouts

SALVINA — Investigators began interviewing Roy Scoville and their parents Tuesday to determine if a Scout leader charged with fondling a boy abused other youngsters in the case, said Sheriff's Detective Lt. Virgil Gammmon.

Victor Ken Hinchert Jr., 34, of 122 Mayfield Colton Drive in Smyrna, was charged Sunday with aggravated sexual battery of a boy under age 13. He is free on \$10,000 bond. Hinchert is scheduled for arraignment in General Sessions Court Oct. 17.

An arrest warrant states Hinchert, with his pants unbuttoned and unbuttoned, tried to lie on top of the boy, then grabbed the boy's groin area. The alleged assault happened at Hinchert's home.

The victim and Hinchert are not related, Gammmon said, but the youngster is a Boy

Scout Hinchert has contact with as a result of his scouting activities.

"From evidence found, we construed he may be classified as a pedophile, but we don't know if that's the case," Gammmon said.

A pedophile is an adult who prefers children as sexual partners.

Detectives found a number of photographs at Hinchert's home showing boys without shirts, said Detective Jim Gage, who along with Detective Chuck Thomas began the investigation Friday.

Hinchert seemed to be an "opinionated," Gage said.

"We don't know if this is an isolated incident," Gammmon said. Because there are possibly more victims involved, Gammmon said, teams of sheriff's detectives and Department of Human Services workers began interviewing potential victims and parents.

"Most kids, we don't feel like, have anything to do with this," Gammmon said. "There are only a few who may have been targeted (by Hinchert)."

However, Gage said, there is a possibility there are victims authorities do not know about.

"If parents are concerned their children have been around this subject, they should contact the sheriff's department for an interview by one of the teams," Gage said.

Concerned parents may call detectives at 898 2207 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., weekdays or 898 2278 at other times.

The district DHS office joined the investigation. Tennessee Bureau of Investigation will also be involved due to the nature of the alleged abuse, Gammmon said. Hinchert does not have a criminal record, Gammmon said, but detectives intend to examine his background thoroughly. Friday's

youngsters have "no psychological problems in the years to come."

"This is extremely traumatic to the victim, especially with the possibility of the Scouting situation," Gammmon said.

Some signs of child sexual abuse are drops in grades, loss of appetite and little interest in school activities, Gammmon said.

"It's traumatic and really affects victims," Gammmon said.

Besides his Boy Scout activities, Hinchert is active in the Smyrna C.R. and Rescue Squad, Gammmon said.

Hinchert is employed as a security officer for Baptist Hospital in Nashville, but was placed on administrative leave without pay pending the outcome of the charges, said Deputy Kerch, a hospital spokeswoman said.

Hinchert, who volunteered as a Scout leader several years ago, coordinated trips and activities for both Boy Scouts and older Explorer scouts.

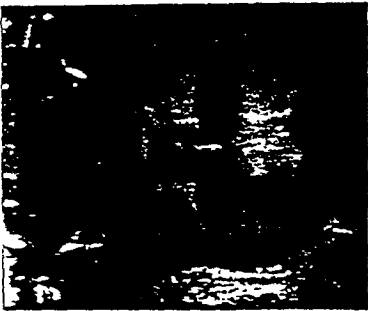
"We will start out with the most recent activities and go back as far as we need to go," Gammmon said.

# Accused child molester drew earlier check

An accused child molester was investigated earlier this year after parents and Boy Scout leaders complained about his methods in teaching their son, a Boy Scout official says.

Ambler Brown of the Scouts Middle Tennessee Council said the complaint alleged Victor Ken Rinehart Sr., a Smyrna Scout leader, asked Scouts to remove shirts during training and Brown who handles the council's public relations. That complaint was not a serious allegation, Brown said. Council executives referred the complaint to state Department of Human Services (DHS) investigators who "felt like it was not a problem," Brown said.

Rinehart, 34, 122 Bailey Collins Drive in Smyrna, was charged Sunday with aggravated sexual battery of a boy under age 18. The youngster is a member of the Boy Scouts.

Donnie Welchance, DHS county director, referred all questions about the earlier complaint to sheriff's Detective J.L. Virgil Gammon, who is coordinating the follow-up in-



Evidence collected by the team may be presented to the grand jury. After Rinehart was arrested Sunday, his registration as a Boy Scout leader was removed, Brown said.

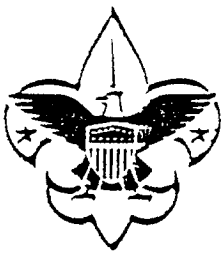

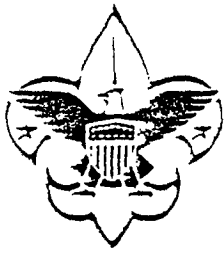

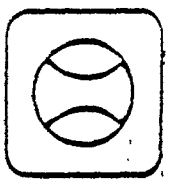
