

Dear Sirs:

I direct this letter to the Appeals Committee.

This began in 1988 at which time I entered, willingly, a substance abuse center. Substance was due to injuries received while in Viet Nam. The appeal was reversed in Nov. of 1988 and served as Assistant Cubmaster for Pack 412. All charges were dropped - there were character letters from members in the Pack; a letter from Epely Substance Abuse center, the police dept. and the chartering organization and my pastor. You have copies of these in your file on me. At that time in 1988 a meeting was set up and attended by myself and your Scout executives at the old twin buildings in K.C.K. She requested the letters mentioned above. I went a second time before these men with the information requested. At that time they told me the charges were dropped and I was reinstated in Pack 412 with Council's blessings. Mr. Joe Osborn was present when I was reinstated as assistant Cubmaster in August 1988.

Since reinstatement I have served as Assistant Cubmaster, Assistant Webelos Den Leader and Webelos Den Leader. Two days after I was notified to step down by telephone, I received my Webelos Den Leader Card for 1991 from Council.

Phone discussions continued and on 2/6/91 I called Dick Riny for an appointment for the 30th of Jan for myself and 707 Cubmaster, Paul Garcia and [REDACTED] whose son is in my Webelos Den. When we went for meeting we were told he was not in & that his secretary would be out to talk with us. Mr Marcus Mack came out instead and we met in his office. We talked and Paul Garcia Cubmaster finally had to just come out and ask "Why does Urigio have to step down?" We were then asked to go to the conference room where we waited about 10 minutes. Mr Mack returned with my file and in front of Paul Garcia and [REDACTED], Mr Mack looked at file and then made statement that "Charges had been dropped. I then asked, "Why do I have to step down again?" His reply was "I don't know."

On 2-12/91 Mr Mack called me and told me about a new found letter "stuck to the back of my file and informed me that appeal was never completed. All information and requests to step down have been by phone. I have received no letter notifying me of same. During

the three years since 88 I have been an active registered leader with a spotless record. I am involved in D.A.R.E. Program and am a registered safe house in my community. I am working with some cub scouts and Boy Scouts who have drug & alcohol problems. I have been asked to reveal these people's name but I have promised boys and parents I would not give their names because they might suffer same condemnations as I am!

I had a problem - I got help - I am helping others. I feel by getting help and helping others I have been a good role model. You are saying if I hadn't reported my rehab I could still be a leader. While there are other leaders out there with same problem and they continue to serve. So, as I see it I am being persecuted not for the substance problem but for getting help with the problem.

I still believe we have enough information to refuse registration should Mr. Fields attempt it in the future. The police department originally had indicated that there had been an assault charge against a juvenile. Mr. Fields also used very poor judgment in holding a den meeting in a pool hall, as well as the fact the he has been admitted to a drug rehabilitation center which indicates to me that he has had some drug problems.

I do not believe this is the type of individual we would want as a leader in Scouting.

I am enclosing a Confidential Record Sheet which I would like to have completed, so that we may identify Mr. Fields. A copy of a paper with his signature would also be most helpful to us in the identification at a later time.



CONFIDENTIAL MEMO

March 31, 1988

As per your request, here is a synopsis of events that have occurred this year concerning Mr. Virgil Fields. Mr. Fields has been registered as a Den Leader with Pack 412, chartered to the Smithville Kiwanis Club.

Early in January, 1988 I spoke on the telephone with a grandmother ([REDACTED]) whose grandson had been in Mr. Fields' den. She said that Mr. Fields had been holding his den meetings in the town pool hall and that she wanted to get her grandson into another den but had been told that the other den(s) was full.

I attempted to contact the registered Cubmaster, Jim McElhany, and did finally make contact in February 1988. He shared with me that Mr. Fields was no longer holding den meetings in the pool hall but rather in his home.

I spoke with Mr. McElhany again, (currently registered as Pack 412's committee chairman) 2½ - 3 weeks ago and he informed me that Mr. Fields had been admitted to the drug rehabilitation Center at Spelman Memorial Hospital, Smithville. Mr. McElhany told me that he was going to speak with the Kiwanis Club's Scouting Coordinator about removing Mr. Fields as a den leader. I suggested that he also discuss the matter with Jim Crocker, the Kiwanis Club President.

On Wednesday, March 23, 1988 I telephoned Mr. McElhany around 6:00 pm to see what, if any, action had been taken. He informed me that he was going to meet that evening with Mr. Crocker and that Mr. Crocker was going to write our council a letter indicating his decision to remove Mr. Fields as a leader. Mr. McElhany said that he would deliver the letter to our council registrar on Thursday afternoon, March 24, 1988.

On Friday, March 25, 1988 I found out from our Council Registrar that no such letter had come to her, and I proceeded to call the Kiwanis Club President only to have him tell me that he had never discussed this matter with Mr. McElhany. I then scheduled a March 29, 1988 meeting with the Club President, Jim Crocker.

On March 29, 1988, Dick Youngstrom (Assistant District Commissioner) and I met with Jim Crocker at the Smithville Post Office where he works. I asked Mr. Crocker if he was aware of any charges being filed against Mr. Fields for assault several weeks ago (information that was offered from a concerned parent to our council office on March 22, 1988). Mr. Crocker stated that he knew only that Virgil Fields was in the hospital.

We told Mr. Crocker that it was up to him as to whether or not he wanted Mr. Fields to be one of his Cub Scout leaders. He said that he would like to go ahead and give us a letter removing Mr. Fields as a leader. A copy of the letter is attached.

Following our meeting with Mr. Crocker, Dick Youngstrom and I went to the Smithville Police Department and spoke with Officer Hickman who stated that Virgil Fields had been charged with assault and that it involved a juvenile. The officer stated that Mr. Fields had not yet been tried and he did not feel that he could share anything further with us in regards to the case.
