Concerns were first brought to me by Scoutmaster, David Lambert on February 14, 1991. That same night I called and set an appointment to talk about the allegations.

We were able to talk in person on February 20, 1991 in their name in Winnsboro. Both parents were present. After getting information from them they allowed me to talk to _____.

and his father first met Mr. Briggs at our Council Winter Camp in November, 1989. Through a common interest in rabbit hunting, a relationship was established.
Mr. Briggs showed an increasing interest in by touching him and by inviting to spend the night in his home. Parents did not permit to stay overnight.
to be on his "staff" at a Cub Mom & Me held in late toper. At this event, Mr. Briggs moved into tent and stayed there for two nights. This was without Council knowledge.
stated that while in the tent, Mr. Briggs hugged and kissed on him for about 20 minutes. Decame very frightened but did not tell anyone.

During the weekend of January 18-19, Mr. Briggs was visiting the home. Both parents and stated Mr. Briggs kept following into his bedroom when parents left the room. Mr. Briggs had done this also during previous visits to the home. This time, according to Mr. Briggs tapped on the nose, told Kevin that he loved him, kissed him on the mouth, attempted to put his tongue in mouth and unbutton his pants.

said that she had seen Mr. Briggs kiss on the lips on another occasion, but felt Mr. Briggs was just too nice a man to be suspicious. The also said Mr. Briggs had told him he loved him on other occasions but could not remember specifically when. Inroughout the family's acquaintance, Mr. Briggs tried to get to spend the night with him in his home.

Dear Sirs:

Since 1947, when I was nine years old, I have been involved with Scouting, either directly or indirectly. Not all of this time has been as a registered member of a unit, but even when it was not practical for me to be active in Scouting, I continued to promote and boost the movement. I have been a participant in and a supporter of Scouting for almost half a century.

As a Cub Scout, I earned the Webelos rank; as a Scout, Eagle; as an Explorer, the Silver Award. I have been to Philmont (1955) and a National Jamboree (1953). Here in Ouachita Valley Council, I have been a Unit Committeeman, Assistant Scoutmaster, and District Commissioner. I have worked effectively with the Council at two Summer Camps, two Winter Camps and numerous short term activities, including Cub Resident Camp last year. In 1990, Ouachita Valley Council asked me to attend National Camping School in order to be better qualified for this volunteer work. I did so, learned a lot, and enjoyed every minute of it.

Scouting has been a major component of my life and I have attempted to impart to succeding generations of Scouts the values that I acquired through Scouting. As an example, Scoutmaster of Troop 62, was a Scout in his Dad's troop in the early 1960's. I was the Assistant Scoutmaster. Now, Bud is the Scoutmaster and his oldest son, is about to complete the requirements for Eagle. I derive a lot of satisfaction from knowing that I have had a positive influence in the lives of these two men. There are many others on whom I believe I have had a positive effect. It is my desire to continue to pass on Scouting's lessons and values and watch the boys with whom I come in contact grow into confidant, productive young men.

On March 1, 1991, I received notification that my registration with the Boy Scouts of America had been revoked because of an allegation of misconduct with a boy. The parents of the members of Troop 62 received a letter the same day informing them of this action. I have since visited with most of the parents and have been gratified by their responses of support and confidence. These people know me; the boys, the young men, their parents. If anything was not right, believe me, they would know it.

Over the past four years I have come in contact with hundreds of boys and scores of adult volunteer leaders. I have earned the respect of most of them and the friendship of many. There has never been any suggestion of misconduct such as was implied in the letter I, and the parents of the members of Troop 62, received March 1. I have done nothing wrong, nothing immoral. I ask that you review this matter most carefully. Consider my history and background in Scouting. Consider the support I have always given Scouting and the positive contributions I have made. There is much I would like to do yet, much I would like to return to Scouting.

I ask that this revocation be rescinded and that my registration in the Boy Scouts of America be restored.
