STATEMENT

This interview takes place on the property adjacent to Camp John B. Gessford, Camp Nelson, California on August the 9th at 2:30 P.M.. Those present at this interview and as witnesses are Mr. Of Simi, California and Mr. Philip Webb of Thousand Oaks, California, both Simoroaks District Scouters.

The subject of the interview is the son of Mr. On a member of the Camp Staff 1970 Camp Gessford, California. The individual making the interview is the Camp Director, C. T. Miller. The purpose of this interview is to make a determination of conversation, actions and activities that took place on Sunday, August the 2nd, 1970 involving the presence of one Mr. Warren K. Ungles, of Simi, California, a registered Edult Scouter as well as Mr. Jr., Camp Staff Member, Camp Gessford, California.

Q. My next question is directed to the Staff Member concerning his knowledge of activities and actions that took place on the afternoon of August the 2nd, 1970 between he and Mr Ingles. Will you relate in your own words the actual happenings as you have related to me, to your father and Mr. Webb previously. After lunch he asked me if I had seen his new car and I told him that I had and he asked me if I would like to take a ride in it. I said sure and asked by friend like Runner to come along and Warren said no he would come bask for him later. So we got in the car and turned on the tape player and started wiving dat of camp. I remember Warren saying that we would go into Camp Nelson to see the girls. So on the way out of camp he asked me if I would like to play a little game. I said ok what? He told me to take my shoes off and argued with him about this point and asked him what was the purpose of this game, he just told me to take my shoes off. I changed the subject from the game

and was talking about other things. A little farther down the road he asked me if I took my shirt off, he would let me drive. To this I just turned around and gave him a flat no. And changed the subject again. When we got to the turn off to go to Camp Nelson, he went the opposite direction and them a little farther down the road he said that he would go as far as to take off my clothes and to take off my clothes and go as far as he thinks I would go with me. completely ignored the question. The he found a place to turn the car around, he turned the car around and started driving out and to the me that he would let me drive if I took my shirt off. And I kept argueing to him about this point. The I told him that I didn't think I should drive and all this stuff like that for I didn't have any insurance. The he said that no one would see me driving and if they did they probably wouldn't ask any questions. He stopped the car then and started to slide across the seat I got out of the car and went around to the orivers seat and started to drive. When I started driving he put his hand to his pants and was playing with himself as far as I could see. Then about a quarter mile from camp he told me to stop the car and let him take over the controls again. So I got out and got into the other side of the car and be broughtene back to camp. And we had our goodbyes and I went my way and he went his.

Q. Now approximately what time in the afternoon of August 2nd did you depart from Camp Gessford? A. About 20 minutes to one. Q. And what time did you return to Camp Gessford? A. About a quarter to two. Q. You mentioned that you had the opportunity to drive this vehicle. Can you identify the vehicle that Mr. Ungles was using at the time of this incident? A. A greenish gray Lincoln Contential. Q. Upon your return to Camp Gessford on August the 2nd, did anyone else from the Camp Gessford Staff depart with Mr. Ungles? A. After me or before me? Q. After you. A. Noone after me that I know of. Q. Had

anyone departed with Mr. Ungles prior to your ride with him? A. who was this individual? A. Have you had any conservation Q. concerning a similar incident? A. Yes. Could you relate to the best of your recollection the discussion that took place between yourself , another member of the Camp Staff? A. Well is I found ou he had gone for a ride before me with Warren and we were discussing our experiences and it seems it started the same way with playing the little game of take your shirt off, do you want to play a little game, take your shoes off and I don't know all of sexperience but from what he told me it was worse than mine. Thats about all I know of his experiences. Q. You state that 's experience was worse than yours, can you relate in approximate words what he had related to you had taken place between him and ingles. A. Well he said, said that he (Ungles) had his peris out in front of him and that he had take his shirt off and told let's drive the car nude. That about all that I know of his experience. Did indicate, mention what his reation to this proposition on the part of Ungles was? A. Just that he was a little shook up and didn't know what quite to do. Q. When was the next time you saw Warren Ungles in camp after this experience on August the 2nd? A. On August the 8th. Q. And did you have any conservation with Mr. Ungles on August the 8th? A. Yes I did. Q. And what was the nature of that conservation. A. Just small talk. Q. Can you be specific as to Small Talk? A. Nothing important, really I don't recall anything that was important. Q. Was it in relationship to the incident of August the 2nd that you just related? A. No, it was not in reference to that. 0 At any time did Mr. Ungles place his hands upon your Not that I recall. Q. At any time did he indecently expose himself in your presence on August 2nd? A. No he did not expose himself. Q. How long have you known Warren Ungles? A. Oh, since about 7th or 8th grade. Q. In

what grade are you in now? A. I will be a Junior. Q. Thats a Junior 誠知igh School? A. Yes. Q. During this period of acquaintance, have you had any reasons to suspect such behavior on behalf of Warren Ungles in the past? A. I haven't. Q. Than this was the first instance of such behavior the best of your knowledge? A. Yes. Q. Upon your return to Camp on August the 2nd of during your conservation on August the 8th with Mr. Ungles, did he at any time ask you not to mention this incident on August the 2nd to any associates or camp officials? A. No, he did not. Q. during this ride on August the 2nd did Mr. Ungles attempt at any time to take your hands or hand and place it any place upon his body? A. No, he did not. Q. What is your date of birth 1954. Q. And what is your address? A. , Santa Susana, Calif. Now you mentioned in reference to your ride with Mr. Ungles on August the 2nd, that you observed him fondling or playing with himself. At this point did he engage in self play by unzipping his trousers or by entering his, placing his hands inside his pants from the belt pontion? Could you describe this act to me please. A. Well, from what I could see he'd slipped his hands in from the waist, he'd untucket his shirt and was playing with himself and this act lasted approximately five minutes or so. Our During the time that he was playing with himself did he utter any werbal discussion or comments while this act was taking place? A. Not that I recall that he did, he was quite. Q. 

This Council is in possession of conclusive evidence that Warren K. Ungles, Troop 606, registered as Assistant Scoutmaster, did engage in action and verbal discussion with minors (Registered Scouts) on August 2 and August 8, 1970 while visiting Camp Gessford Summer Camp, operated by the Ventura County Council, such propositions that fall in the areas of sexual deviation.

No legal action will be taken. Written resignation has been obtained from Mr. Warren K. Ungles, removing himself from the position of a registered Scouter. Parents of boys concerned have been notified of the action taken, as well as the sponsoring institution.

Supporting documentation will follow in approximately two weeks. Similar behavior has been reported by the San Fernando Valley Council on the part of Ungles on or about August 6th or 7th. We request that Ungles be placed or the "Confidential" file as being unsuitable for leadership within the Boy Scouts of America.
