Dear Paul,

I am enclosing a confidential report sheet on a Mr. Wes Monroe of Kearns, Utah. In completing the new adult leader application Mr. Monroe indicated that he had been arrested and convicted of child abuse. We have meet with the head of the sponsoring organization and they have removed him from all involvement in youth activities. I have also checked with the Salt Lake County Sheriffs department and have learned that Mr. Monroe was convicted of sexual child abuse and served a 5 week jail sentence beginning May of 1986.

Mr. Monroe has been advised by his Bishop who is the sponsor head, that he is not eligible to serve as a leader in Scouting and therefore has withdrawn his application. I feel it awkward in this situation to try to obtain additional information called for on our confidential sheet. However, if you need it we will take care of it.
