Dear Clint:

Leonard Thompson of your staff has written us a letter of inquiry concerning one Wilfrid Dionne who is registered with you as an Assistant Scoutmaster in Troop 17, Portland. Mr. Thompson further indicates that this man has also used the name of Wilfrid Doiron and that he may have been previously registered in the Daniel Webster Council in Manchester, New Hampshire.

Please advise Mr. Thompson that Mr. Dionne's real name is Wilfred Donat Doiron, and that Dionne name is an alias. He was registered in New Hampshire as Assistant Scoutmaster in Troops 101 and 110 back in 1959 to 1961. We do not know of any Scouting activities in 1967 or 1968, although he may have been unofficially connected and not registered.

Mr. Thompson's inquiry is the more interesting because only this Spring we received an application for Wilfred Doiron, who gave an address of 57 Central Street, Northfield, Vermont, to serve as Assistant Scoutmaster for Troop 559 in the Long Trail Council. We refused his registration at that time.

As you know, we do not give reasons why persons are placed on the Confidential File, but I can assure you that the reasons why we are unwilling to accept Mr. Doiron's registration in Scouting are good and well authenticated and we would never, knowingly, be willing to accept his registration in the Scouting program.

When informing Mr. Doiron about this, simply tell him that the National Council does not wish to accept his registration in the Boy Scouts of America. If he should raise any questions as to reason, you might indicate to him that registration in the Boy Scouts of America is a privilege and not a right and that the National Council reserves the prerogative to accept those individuals it feels will best serve the interests of the organization.

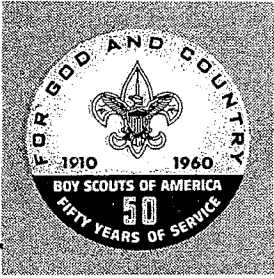

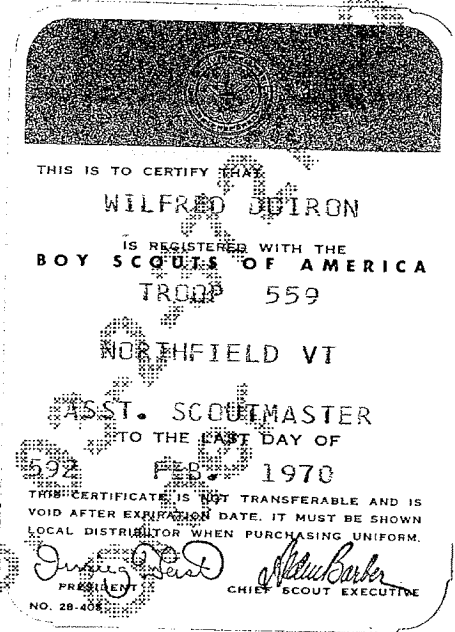

You undoubtedly will ask, "Why?", since Mr. Doiron is a "B" Scouter and he was registered as Assistant Scoutmaster in this same troop last year. Unfortunately, through a clerical oversight on our part, Mr. Doiron's registration slipped through the cracks last year and his application for registration got through. For this error, please accept our sincerest apologies.

As you know, we never divulge any of the information in our files, however, let me tell you that the information we have concerning Mr. Doiron is of such a nature, that we would be completely unwilling to ever again, knowingly, accept his registration in the Boy Scouts of America.

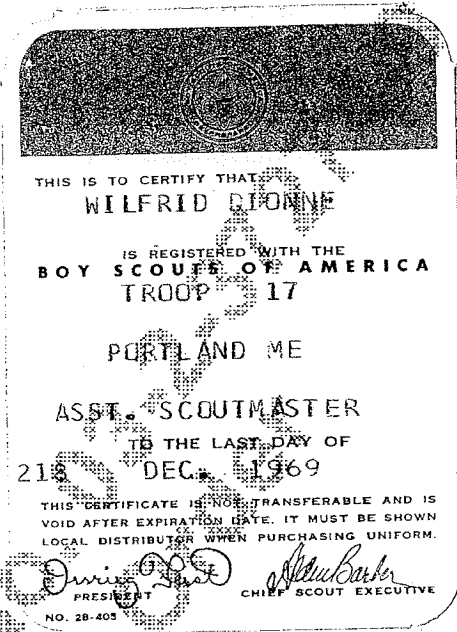
