Murder trial begins in Indian River court

FLORIDA TODAY Staff Writers

VERO BEACH — A 12-member jury will hear opening arguments today in the trial of a Wabasso man charged with the first-degree murder of his wife in May 1988.

Eugene Hubler, 44, of Irby Trailer Court, is accused of fatally shooting his wife, Linda Hubler, and then burying her near Sebastian.

Assistant State Attorney David Morgan is prosecuting, and Hubler is defended by Public Defender Phil Yacucci. Arguments begin at 9:30 a.m. in Judge Paul Kanarek's courtroom.

Vero may ban development

VERO BEACH — The Vero Beach City Council is considering a moratorium on rezonings on the barrier island until traffic problems are solved.

The council voted Tuesday night to hold a public hearing on an ordinance banning development along a five-mile stretch of the barrier island within the city.

The proposed ordinance would include an area from the ocean to the Indian River Lagoon and from the south city limits to the town of Indian River Shores.

Residents of the island gathered about 1,500 signatures in favor of limiting development along SR A1A.

Deputies arrest Cocoa man

Sheriff's deputies have arrested a Cocoa man in connection with the sexual battery of 9-year-old girl.

William Franklin Vickers, 64, of 2574 Stratford Drive, was arrested on Tuesday by Sgt. Bob Leatherow of the Brevard County Sheriff's Office. Vickers was charged with three counts of sexual battery.

We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of membership the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a Council Review Committee, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated.
