XENIA (AP) — A former youth ministry leader found guilty of gross sexual imposition has been placed on five years' probation.

William F. Strausbach was sentenced Tuesday by Judge Edward R. Kimmel of Greene County Common Pleas Court.

Strausbach, 52, had pleaded guilty in January to one count of gross sexual imposition. He had been indicted on Oct. 10 and was accused of having sexual contact with a child under 13 in 1976 and with contributing to the delinquency of a minor during the summer of 1983.

XENIA — William F. Strausbach, a former youth ministry leader found guilty of gross sexual imposition in January, on Tuesday was placed on five years' probation by Greene County Common Pleas Judge Edward R. Kimmel.

In January, Strausbach, 52, of Xenia Twp., pleaded no contest to a third-degree felony charge of gross sexual imposition, and Kimmel found him guilty of a lesser form of the charge.

During Tuesday's hearing, Kimmel sentenced Strausbach to 18 months at the Chillicothe Correctional Institute and six months in the Greene County

jail, but suspended both sentences and placed Strausbach on probation.

Strausbach must continue to seek counseling as a condition of his probation, Kimmel said.

A Greene County grand jury indicted Strausbach on Oct. 10. He was accused of having sexual contact with a child under 13 in 1976 and contributing to the delinquency of a minor during the summer of 1983.

The assaults, according to assistant Greene County Prosecutor Steve Wo-laver, occurred on church-sponsored outings with Strausbach, who was a youth ministry leader for the First Evangelical Lutheran Church of Xenia.




