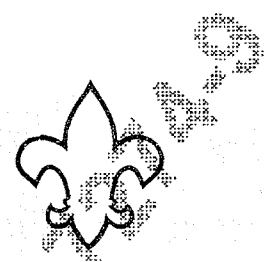


Dear Paul:
