



## Man Arraigned Here On Charge of Lewd Act

A Rutland man was arraigned in Municipal Court here Saturday on a charge of having lewd re-lations with a local 11-year-old

boy. William J. Moreau, 27, was re-

William J. Moreau, 27, was released in \$3,000 bail after Judge Richard Sullivan continued the case to Monday for further investigation. State's Atty. Arthur E. Crowley said the offense happened earlier this month.

The boy's father brought the first complaint to city police last Thursday, and Moreau gave himself up at the station Friday, law officials stated. Atty. Donald H. Hackel of Rutland represented Moreau at the Saturday arraignment. ment.

Dear Bob,

As per your suggestion on the telephone last might I am sending this letter with what information I have as of 3:45 this aftermoon concerning the morals case of William Moreau.

Last evening my Council President and I were invited by the local police department to hear a story from an eleven year old Boy Scout in Troop 7, Rutland. Upon arriving at the station we spent a good half hour trying to locate Moreau but had no success. After about an hour of encouraging questions on our part, the boy finally told us of an immoral act that he and Moreau, his assistant Scoutmaster, committed Saturday evening April 1, 1961.

This boy was one of about a dozen Scouts who stayed overnight in the Vaughan Lodge at Camp Sunrise. Moreau was their leader. The voluntary admission of this act as related by the boy never used the words "forced me" or "made me". We were unable to locate Moreau and so could not get his side of the story.

The parents, though appreciative of our concern for their son and the name of the Scouting movement, are anxious to press charges. In fact, I have just talked with Officer Barrett and he is in the process of making formal charges. Moreau has not been seen since 7:30 last night. The States Attorney with whom I talked late last night and the local police assure me they will do everything in their power to keep Scouting's name and Camp Sunrise out of this. Our local paper, The Rutland Herald, has a policy which states that names of boys under 16 will not be used.

At your request I have just talked with Warren Holm at the Home Office, i.r. Wilson being away. I've advised him of this situation.

William Moreau, age 27, about 5 10" tall, 185 lbs, brown hair, is the registered assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 7 sponsored by the United Commercial Travelers. He is of Protestant faith, single and works as a free-lance insurance adjuster. He served for a time as Scoutmaster in Essex Junction, Vermont. My President and I are still trying to contact him so that we might get his side of the story.

I shall keep you informed as events unfold.
