Rumors of his having favorite boys share his tent on camping trips and having boys stay at his apartment overnight came from parents.

A check of police department records indicated his conviction of sodomy in 1963 for which he served six months in fail and was placed on five years probation.

Situation - Scoutmaster has had no supervision from the Troop committee and got way out in left field on Scouts selling sweetbread, etc., all over town in uniform. Also, Charter has been lapsed two months.

In investigating this problem I uncovered a number of camping situations where Green was the only adult and always had a Scout with him in his tent, etc. Both school counselors and two fathers interviewed felt that Green was not fit to be working with boys.

I checked the police department and found that Green had been convicted of sodomy in 1963 in Honolulu and was placed on probation for five years.



Green. Some of the circumstances involved on Mr. Green are contained in the memorandum from Gene Weston to me, which I believe will give enough evidence for disqualification.



It has come to our attention that William Green who was Scoutmaster of Troop 107 at Paloto School has been using the Scouts to sell merchandise door to door in Scout and Explorer uniform which is entirely contrary to the policies of the Boy Scouts of America.

The charter for Truep 102 which is listed to the Poleio School P.T.A. expired is January 1966 and has not been reserved. Therefore, none of the boys nor Mr. Green is sufficiently to weak the uniform or to represent themselves as Boy Scouts or Explorent.

Until such a time as the charter of the troop is again in large, troop 107 does not exist. Since your son was committed with this group I am taking this appartunity to advise you of the situation. It would be to your advantage to investigate Mr. Green as to his suffatility to work with your son.

We have notified Mr. Green that he is no langur registered with the Boy-Scouts of America and that any further selling of merchandles in the name of the Boy Scouts will be dealt with severely.
