Mr. Lazareski came to see me at 10:30 a.m. on Monday, May 23rd, 1988. He attempted to register as a Tiger Cub parent during the week of May 16th and was told by our Registration Department that he could not register. He had previously tried to register as a member of the Troop Committee for Troop 20 Johnston. He was picked up on the Confidential File for activities in this Council in 1971 or 1972.

During the conversation I told him that I was sure he could register as a parent of a Tiger Cub but he could not register as an adult leader in the Cub Pack or the Boy Scout Troop, the District or the Council, or any other leadership position with the Boy Scouts.

After conversation with him was completed, I called Paul Ernst and verified the fact that he could participate as a parent of a Tiger Cub. Paul assurred me that they would accept his registration as a Tiger Cub parent.

I called Ron Webster, Cubmaster of Pack 1, and gave him essentially the same information that Mr. Lazareski could register as a Tiger Cub parent but he could not register as an adult leader in the Boy Scouts. He askedme why and I told him it was not necessary to know why but just that the Boy Scouts of America would not accept his registration.

I will call Mr. Lazareski today and tell him that his registration as a Tiger Cub parent is being processed.

Dear Parky:

The following is a factual account of the incident that occured with two individuals from Troop 22 Providence on July 31, 1971 at Yawgoog Scout Reservation:

master Agostina Giardina observed Assistant Scoutmaster William Lazzareschi and Scout Committing the act of fellatio. Scout acted in the active role and Assistant Scoutmaster Lazzareshi participated in the passive role. Scout is twelve years old.

Mr. Giardina found them committing this act behind a tent when he was looking for one Scout missing from his head count when returning from the Camp Show. He immediately asked them what they were doing and they said that they were filling up their lantern. Mr. Giardina has a very bad heart and felt for his own health that he should not pursue the matter at that time. He also felt that if he made too much fuss at that time, the rest of the camp would have been alerted to what happened.

Sunday morning, Scoutmaster Giardina discreetly called the boy aside and asked him what had happened the night before. The boy stated that "Mr. Lazzareschi made me do it to him".

The matter was brought to the attention of the Assistant Reservation Director, Philip E. Tracy, and he called Assistant Scoutmaster Lazzareschi in to discuss the matter. Mr. Lazzareschi was confronted with the facts and admitted his role in the act and stated that he had never done anything like it before.

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Mr. Lazzareschi was told by the Assistant Reservation Director that a report would be made to the Scout Executive and subsequently to the National Office and that he would no longer be allowed to serve in any adult capacity in Scouting. The subject is also involved with Cub Pack 10 Johnston and he was informed that he should remove himself from their roster immediately. He was also advised to stay away from Scout

Scout was counseled by Reverend Edmond C. Micarelli, the Scout Chaplain for Scouts of Catholic Faith, regarding his participation in this act, with positive results. Upon Father Micarelli's recommendation, the parents were not notified.

Assistant Scoutmaster Lazzareschi rejoined Troop 22 Providence in September 1970 after returning from a term in the Army.

He is employed by the Star Market, Cranston, Rhode Island; is 24 years of age; unmarried; is approximately 5'10" in height and weighs approximately 180 pounds. He has brown hair, and blue eyes. He is attending Providence College evenings and is about to become engaged to his girl friend. His present address is Rhode Island. He is living with his parents.
