Man pleads guilty to enticing boys to toy-filled house, assaulting them

24 other charges dropped

By Joyce Trent/Gazette Telegraph

A former sports coach who admitted molesting children he attracted to his house by filling it with toys pleaded guilty Monday to six sex crimes involving four young boys.

William Sonju, 29, will have 24 other criminal charges, involving eight other children, dismissed

as part of the plea bargain.

Nevertheless, he could spend the rest of his life in prison. Prosecutor Bill Aspinwall is considering requesting that Sonju be declared a sex offender, which is punishable by a term of one day to life.

To place Sonju in that category, 4th Judicial District Judge Matt Railey would have to find that Sonju constitutes a continuing threat to the public. Sentencing is set for Dec. 21.

A self-employed wood cutter, Sonju was a volunteer coach for the YMCA and the Colorado Springs Park and Recreation Department. But he met the children listed as his victims outside of those programs.

He became acquainted with one child through a former co-worker, baby-sitting for the boy for two years before his behavior was discovered. He met the other 7- to 10-year-olds in his neighborhood or through other children.

The children said Sonju had video games, a place for shooting BB guns, a treehouse, a guitar and other toys on the premises, and he encouraged them to play there.

Sonju pleaded guilty to three counts of sexual assault on a child while in a position of trust and four counts of enticing a child into his house to commit sexual assault.

To be dismissed are 14 counts of sexual assault on a child and 10 counts of enticing a child into his home to commit sexual assault.

If Sonju is not sentenced as a sex offender, he could receive a prison term of up to 144 years. To impose that much, Railey would have to determine there were aggravating circumstances in each case and Sonju should serve each term one after the other instead of at the same time.

Youth team coach arrested in assaults on 14 children

By Kathryn Martin/Gazette Telegraph

A Colorado Springs man who coached sports for the YMCA and the park department has been arrested as a suspect in the sexual assault of 14 children between the ages of 8 and 10, police said.

William Vinton Sonju, 29, of 5640 Del Rey Drive, was arrested March 31 and again Thursday in a string of assaults that began in September 1986. He may face as many as 13 charges of sexual assault on a child and enticing a child.

Sonju was held in lieu of \$116,000 bail Thursday in the El Paso County jail. Authorities said the parent of one of the alleged victims had been trying to post bail for Sonju.

In at least five cases, the children were allegedly molested as Sonju served as their baby sitter, court records show.

Sonju reportedly told the boy and other children that he would buy them Nintendo video games, according to records.

"He was very friendly. He kept toys and games for the kids and let them have the run of (his) house," police Lt. Joe Vernier said.

Last fall, Sonju began coaching fifth- and

sixth-graders in a Youth Basketball Association team for the YMCA of the Pikes Peak Region.

YMCA officials removed Sonju earlier this year when police told them that he was under investigation, said director Jim Klever.



Sonju: Arrested twice in a string of sexual assaults.

"We have policies for our staff and our volunteers that people are removed from contact in any way with children in our program until they are proven innocent or guilty," he said.

Sonju could resume coaching for the YMCA if he is cleared of all charges, Klever said. The YMCA screens all volunteers for prior arrests. Sonju did not have a police record before his March 31 arrest, authorities said.

Police said Sonju was a volunteer coach for the Colorado Springs Park and Recreation Department.

Court records state Sonju admitted fondling at least three of the children. He reportedly told police he always asked permission before touching a child and stopped when told.
