Your letter dated January 24, 1984 was received today.

Your letter was addressed to Mr. Billy W. Willig, Council President, but Mr. Willig is no longer the president; Mr. Baugh Lewis is the current Council President.

Therefore, I am answering your letter regarding the status of relationship with the Boy Scouts of America.

Mr. Sheedy, as stated in the letter to you on November 22, 1983, your registration status was reviewed and it was determined that your registration was suspended.

You should be aware that your records on file in the District Court of Uvalde Texas, Cause #4742 and County Court of Uvalde Texas Cause #14439 are a matter of public record.

If you desire to have these matters reviewed by a committee, appointed by the Council President; then you should make a request in writing to the Council President.

If you desire to have these matters reviewed by an appointed committee you must follow this procedure:

1. Make a written request to include your version of the facts related to the previous convictions which would support your claim that registration should not be denied.
2. Include with your letter any documents to support your claim.

would not be today.


So all I ask for is a

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN OF THE JURY:

By your verdict returned in this case you have found the defendant guilty of the offense charged in the information, to-wit: Solicitation of a Child, which was alleged to have been committed on or about the 21st day of April, 1982 in Uvalde County, Texas.

1.

The information also alleges that prior to the commission of the offense for which you returned a verdict herein, the defendant was previously convicted on February 17, 1976 of a Felony, to-wit: Indecency with a Child, in Cause No. 4742, District Court of Uvalde, Texas. To these allegations defendant has pleaded "not true."

2.

Now, if you find from the evidence beyond a reasonable doubt that prior to the commission of the offense of Solicitation of a Child, of which you have found defendant guilty, he was duly and legally convicted of a felony less than capital, as follows:

Indecency with a Child, in Cause No. 4742, District Court of Uvalde, Texas,


and that such conviction in Cause No. 4742 for Indecency with a Child occurred, and that the judgment therein became final prior to the commission of the offense of Solicitation of a Child for which you have found defendant guilty;

And that the defendant, WILLIE CHARLES SHEEDY, is the same person who was so convicted in said Cause number 4742, aforesaid;

Then, in such event you will find the allegations are "true" and so state your verdict in the form provided for that purpose and attached to this charge.

Unless you so find from the evidence beyond a reasonable doubt, or if you have a reasonable doubt thereof, then you will restrict your consideration to the matter of punishment for the offense of Solicitation of a Child, of which you have found defendant guilty and assess the punishment at a fine not to exceed \$2,000.00 or confinement in jail for a term not to exceed one (1) year, or BOTH fine and imprisonment.

Two forms of verdict are provided below for your use, and only one verdict may be returned by the jury; the foreman will fill in the appropriate form of verdict to conform with the jury's determination. The jury's verdict must be unanimously agree to by all the members of the jury and signed by the foreman.

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
FORMS OF VERDICT

We, the jury, having found the defendant guilty of Solicitation of a Child, as charged in the Information, find the allegations with respect to prior convictions, as alleged in the Information, to be "not true", and we assess his punishment at _____

We, the jury, having found defendant guilty of Solicitation of a Child, as charged in the Information, further find from the evidence beyond a reasonable doubt that he was, prior to the commission of the aforesaid offense of Solicitation of a Child, duly and legally convicted of a felony less than capital, as charged in the Information in this case, and, therefore, that the allegations with respect to said prior convictions, as alleged in the information, are "true".






In response to your letter regarding Mr. Willie C. Sheedy and his arrest record since 1975-76, I can only add the following:

1. Mr. Sheedy was arrested, convicted and served a one-year sentence in the Uvalde County Jail for the same offense. The jail term was served in 1981-82.
2. He is currently under surveillance by the Police in the City of Uvalde, Texas. The police have received an inquirey from one of the parents of a Webelos Scout and to date nothing has developed.

The Cubmaster of the Cub Pack Mr. Ramon Castro has delivered the letter of suspension and we have mailed Mr. Sheedy a registration refund.


