I met on June 2, 1987 at 4:30 PM with [redacted] Englewood, OH, [redacted]; [redacted] Dayton, OH, [redacted] Big Bear District Commissioner Mike Schindler and Big Bear District Chairman Bob Roberts at Bob Roberts home for the purpose of hearing accusations of child molesting and homosexuality against Winston Blythe, Unit Commissioner. Blythe is employed at [redacted] which is owned by his mother.

[redacted] reported that on March 5, 1987 she unexpectedly walked in on Winston at the kennel. A young man, age 17, was with Winston, lying on the floor with his pants lowered to his ankles. Winston admitted to her that he has homosexual tendencies, but denied having homosexual relations with minors. She has frequently seen Winston in an affectionate situation with other boys, particularly youth who he has employed from Montgomery County J.V.S. Allegedly J.V.S. will no longer send boys to the kennels.

[redacted] reported that a boy, [redacted], told her Winston has "bothered him". She said that [redacted], has told her that Winston has molested both of her boys, [redacted]. We called [redacted] on the speaker phone. Her younger son, [redacted] told her that Winston put his hands down the back of his pants. This happened about 3 years ago. [redacted], the older son, told her that Winston molested him (or attempted to) but won't talk with her about it. The family no longer maintains relations with Winston.

According to [redacted] in 1984 Winston molested a boy [redacted], in the washroom at the Madison Twp. Fire Department. A police report was filed, then withdrawn when Winston was fired by the Fire Department.

(We have two confirming pieces of evidence here - [redacted] called our office in August 1986 and reported this to us. She did not leave her phone number and we were not able to locate her. She did not indicate which fire department and we were unable to confirm anything at that time. A phone call June 3 by Bob Roberts to a reliable government source also confirmed this.)

[redacted] and [redacted] shared with us significant additional speculation of possible homosexual activity with boys, but everything was circumstantial.

The only Scouting related episode mentioned was that a Scout, [redacted] has spent the night with Winston on several occasions, sleeping in his bed even though other beds were available. Winston has an openly affectionate relationship with this Scout.

Dear Mr. Blythe:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be reinstated.



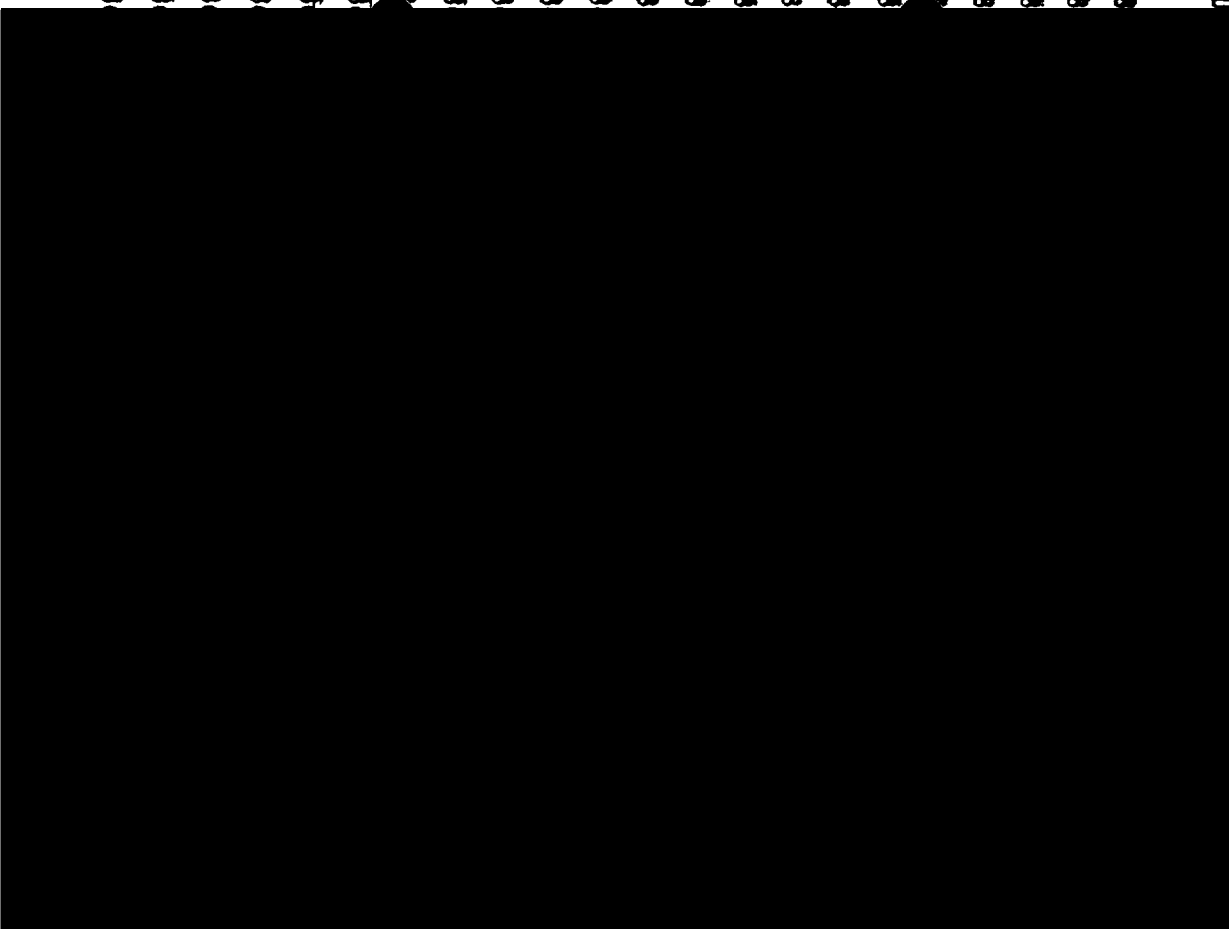
