Judd, a native resident who has taught in Mesa schools for 25 years. was an industrial cooperative teacher at Mesa and Westwood high schools when he was arrested Sept. 4. He was indicted Sept. 18 on one count of sexual assault, one count of sexual abuse and seven counts of child molestation.

Judd, whose resignation took effect on Oct. 9, his 50th birthday, told police he had molested children since the 1960s, according to Superior Court records.

As he submitted his plea bargain Monday, the judge asked Judd to explain details of the molestation.

Judd said the incident occurred at a Mesa park with relatives at a family reunion Sept. 10, 1985. While a 6-year-old girl was on his lap, he fondled her, Judd said.

After the private hearing Monday, Farnsworth said his client had to accept the plea bargain because, had the case gone to trial, he faced a prison term of more than 150 years.

Farnsworth said he would have taken Judd's case to trial "if he hadn't confessed." When arrested by police two months ago, Judd admitted to one of the allegations, police records show.

According to police, one of the alleged victims was 10 years old and said she had been molested since 1984. Another victim, now 17, said she had been molested from 1983 to 1985.

Besides his teaching career, Judd has been a girls' camp counselor and a Boy Scout adviser. After his wife posted a \$34,250 bond, Judd was released from jail almost three weeks ago.

Ex-teacher pleads guilty to molesting

Under the plea agreement, Larry Wright Judd, 50, is ineligible for early parole and must serve the entire prison term he receives — a minimum of 12 years.

If his plea to one charge of child molestation is accepted at sentencing, the agreement calls for the other charges to be dismissed.

On Monday, Superior Court Judge Sally Gaines, Deputy Maricopa County Attorney Ed Cook and defense attorney E. Evans Farnsworth, went over the plea bargain with Judd, emphasizing that it prevents any early release.

"So you're definitely going to prison. You understand that?" the judge asked Judd, who was accompanied by his wife, Barbara.

"Right," Judd whispered, nodding.

Judd is scheduled for sentencing Dec. 17, but that date is expected to be delayed until January so his attorney can present testimony from friends and counselors regarding Judd's background and his chances of rehabilitation.

Teacher faces child-sex charges

A veteran Mesa High School teacher, who also served as a youth counselor at a church summer camp, was charged Thursday with three felony counts of child molestation and sexual abuse.

Police said some of the alleged offenses occurred at church, at the camp and at his house.

He was the second educator from Mesa

Public Schools in less than a month to be charged with sex-related offenses.

The Maricopa County Attorney's Office issued a complaint Thursday pirst Larry Wright Judd, 49, of 1701 E. Halifax St. He was charged with one count of sexual assault and two counts of child molestation.

Judd was arrested by Mesa police about 7:30 p.m. Wednesday and booked into the city jail for investigation of seven counts of child molestation, one count of sexual assault, one count of sexual abuse with a person 15 years old

and one count of sexual abuse with a child under 15, according to police records.

Judd made his initial appearance in East Mesa Justice Court Thursday and was released on his own recognizance by Judge Gail G. Goodman, much to the annoyance of Mesa police.

"When we have this type of offense, we ask that there be a bond set," said police spokesman Sgt. Mike Hayes.

Judd's wife, Barbara, referred inquiries Thursday to Judd's Mesa attorney, E. Evuns Farnsworth, who could not be reached for comment.

Judd is suspected of molesting a 10-year-old Mesa girl from January 1984 to last March. The girl's mother reported the incidents to police on May 30, a day after Judd was questioned by police.

The girl's parents told police Judd was a trusted friend and a fellow member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. They said their children have visited his home on numerous occasions.

When questioned by police, the child referred to Judd as "brother Judd."

Another girl, who is now 17, accused Judd of molesting her from July 1983 to August of 1985, police said. The girl's mother, who was a counselor at a Mormon youth camp last summer, said she was suspicious about Judd and asked that he not be a counselor there.

"I had nothing to base, you know, my feeling on, just a woman's intuition ... So I fought tooth and nail, trying to keep him from girls' camp," she told police. "But my decison was overridden, and they said they felt that he would be fine."

A church spokesman could not be reached for comment Thursday.

The girl told police she had made notations in her diary about several alleged molestations.

James Zaharis, superintendent of the Mesa Unified School District, said: "It's a tragic thing for the familles and everyone involved. We hope that it's an isolated incident. We have to know that our community is not immune to the things that happen in the world."

Judd is the second Mesa teacher formally charged with sex-related offenses with minors in less than a month.

Kenneth Lamberton, 27, was arrested Aug. 18 and indicted Wednesday by a Pinal County grand jury on felony charges alleging sexual conduct with one of his former students, Kelly Gregan, 14, of East Mesa.

Teacher charged in abuse

Admits sexual tickling of 3 girls, police say.

MESA - A Mesa high school teacher described as a "dedicated youth worker" with the Mormon Church has been arrested and charged with sexual assault and child molestation.

Larry Wright Judd, 49, who was arrested Wednesday night, was released on his own recognizance. Thursday after appearing in East Mesa Justice Court. He is scheduled for a preliminary hearing before Judge Gail Goodman on Sept. 18.

The alleged incidents did not involve his students, but young girls from his neighborhood or church, according to police records.

In one case, a 15-year-old girl was urged by her mother to apologize to Judd after the girl accused him of fondling her, police said.

The girl's mother, contacted by telephone in Cairo, Egypt, where the family is now living, said; "I wish I knew then what I know-now. I believe my daughter, and I hope he gets the help he needs."

She said adults had questioned the girl's story because they could not believe such a "well-respected man would have done such a thing."

When Judd was brought in for questioning by police, he admitted to "tickling and rubbing some of the children on their vaginas," according to police reports.

A woman answering the telephone at Judd's residence said he would not talk to reporters. Judd's attorney, Evan Farnsworth, was reported to be ill and could not be reached for comment.

Judd, a 25-year teaching veteran, teaches industrial-cooperative education at Mesa and Westwood high schools, Assistant Superintendent Pat Pomeroy said. Judd was Pomeroy
